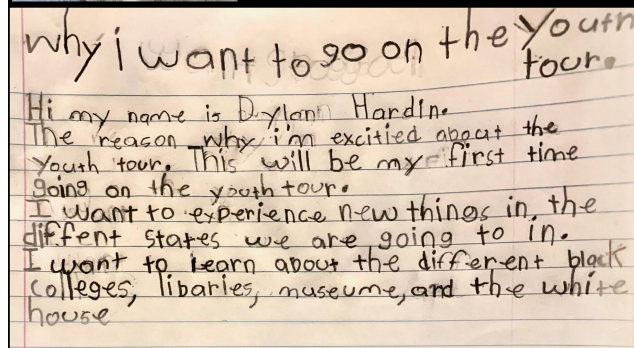
YT 2024: Southeast Exploratory Expedition

An Empowerment 4 Generations, Inc Boost



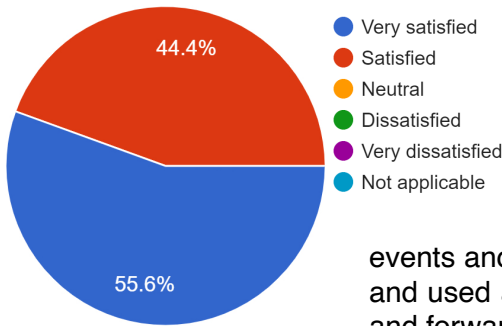
