Pastor's Notes

This Sunday, June 5th, is my 35th anniversary to the priesthood. In anticipation of the meal planned on the 4th, I share my sincere gratitude and thank all those who worked so hard to make it happen, to all who are cooking and serving. Words cannot express my thanks. Thank you to all who have sent personal greetings via cards, notes, and verbal well wishes. Thank you!

I recall many priest's and sister's anniversary celebrations. Many of them express how the years seemed to pass by in a wink of an eye. And so it is with me. I recall my first assignment was at St. Mary's Cathedral. Fr. Robert Chamberlain was my pastor. At that time, he was of similar age and years ordained as I am now. I was newly ordained, 29 years old, and I thought to myself, "Wow, I wonder if I can make it that long?" It seemed like forever. Yet, here I am today.

Friday, June 5, 1987, was a very humid afternoon. I was ordained at Saint Mary's Cathedral in Grand Island, by Bishop McNamara. It was an occasion that is indescribable. Over the years I have served across the Diocese of Grand Island, from Grand Island to Scottsbluff and now in the middle, Kearney. Over 25 years I served the Spanish speaking community; learning Spanish on the job. For a time, I was the Vicar of Hispanic ministry.

As with most priests of the Diocese I have served on many councils and boards. I am currently the Dean for the Kearney deanery.

All in all, it has been a wonderful life. No matter where I was called to serve, my priority was to be a prayerful priest and a good pastor.

For those who are eligible, I encourage you to pray about a vocation to the priesthood or the religious life. The church is in great need of priests, deacons, sisters, and brothers.

Please continue to pray for vocations!

God bless and thank you all! It is a blessing for me to be your priest and pastor!

Accepting God's Call: As we are moving back to life the way it was pre-covid, we are gratefully accepting new liturgical ministers. If you would like to be trained for any liturgical ministry, please contact the office and we will make sure you will be trained.

For those who are serving the Lord at Mass, please help us continue to have dynamic Masses by signing up for ministries. If for whatever reason you are unable to attend the Mass for which you are scheduled, please find a substitute. If you are signed up, it is very important that you check in so that the coordinator of the Mass will know you are here and not find someone else to do your ministry. Your active participation in the ministries and in the Mass give glory to God, to His Son Jesus and the Holy Spirit. I pray you have a prayerfully, renewing, safe summer.

Phase II news: Bishop Hanefeldt has given us permission to move forward with detailed architectural plans. The team will be meeting with Joseph Kotulak, of RDG, to develop those plans. After more than 21 listening sessions, it seems the community of Prince of Peace has made its voice known. The goals are to build a gathering space with parish offices south of this space. The current office space will be repurposed for additional and much needed classroom space. There will also be some work on the parking lot.

At this time there is \$2,183,060 pledged and an additional \$148,395 from Fr. O'Conner's estate which gives us more than \$2.33 million towards the project. All parishioners are asked to prayerfully consider giving 3% of their annual income for three years. If you haven't made a pledge or gift, you can do so by contacting the office.

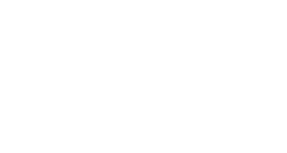
