Last Friday, June 6, 2025, James (Jimmy) Beran was ordained into the priesthood for the diocese of Grand Island! He is now known as Father Jimmy Beran! We are grateful that he came to us from St. Peter's in Lincoln, Nebraska. It was an incredible Mass; the music was outstanding. It is difficult to describe the beauty of a priestly ordination. The church is filled with bishops, the clergy and, of course, the candidate's family, friends, and members of the diocese alike. There is a sense of great joy and hope! Fr. Beran will serve as the associate pastor of the Cathedral of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Grand Island. We have not had a priestly ordination since Fr. Matthew Nash on June 9, 2017. There are five men currently in seminary. This fall Noah Huddleston will be ordained a transitional deacon and next year a priest.

Priestly vocations begin in the home. Parents can be helpful by encouraging their children to consider a priestly vocation or a religious vocation to the consecrated life. Fervent prayer for vocations also helps a great deal. May God grant us many priestly vocations.

This Sunday is Trinity Sunday. God reveals himself in many ways: the burning bush to Moses, the whisper to Elisha, and as a dove over Jesus at His baptism. In scripture, especially in the Gospel of John, chapter 1, God reveals himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is a mystery that will take a lifetime to understand.

There is a story that St. Augustine was walking on the beach contemplating the mystery of the Trinity. Then he saw a boy in front of him who had dug a hole in the sand and was going out to the sea again and again and bringing some water to pour into the hole. St. Augustine asked him, "What are you doing?"

The boy replied, "I'm going to pour the entire ocean into this hole."

Confused, St. Augustine said, "That is impossible, the whole ocean will not fit in the hole you have made."

The boy replied, "And you cannot fit the Trinity in your tiny little brain."

The story concludes by saying that the boy vanished because St. Augustine had been talking to

an angel.

This weekend we have a mission appeal for Crossroads Catholic. I hope you will be generous.

I am away this weekend as my niece, Allison Corcoran, is getting married June 14 at the church of the Holy Ghost in Denver. How I wish I could savor another weekend with my Prince of Peace friends, but she is my niece and I do love her.



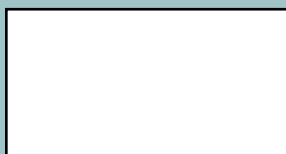
