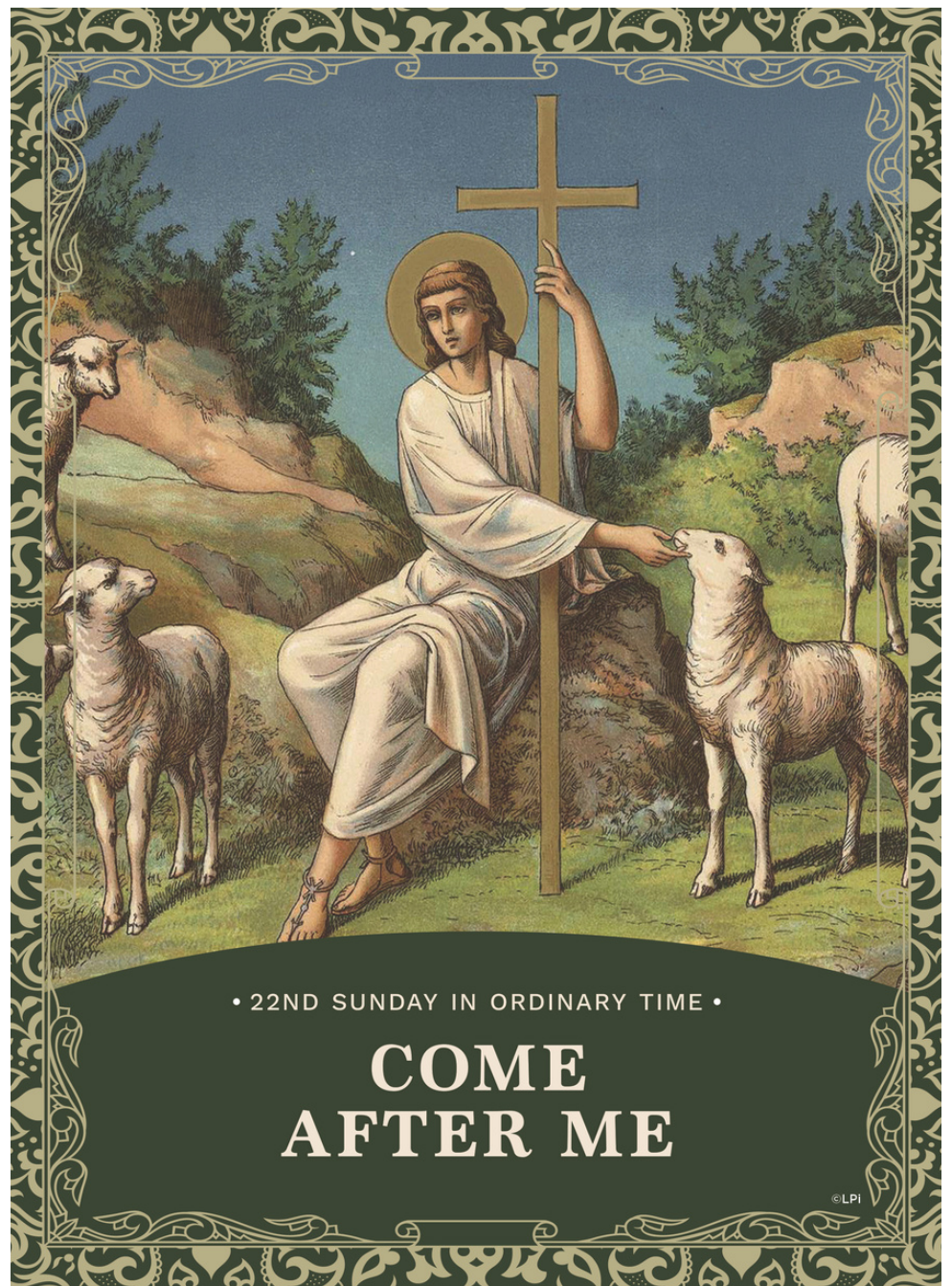
FR. SCOTT HARTER

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HOW THE SAINTS BATTLED LUST

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According to the Catechism, lust is the, “disordered desire for inordinate enjoyment of sexual pleasure,” and becomes morally wrong when sexual pleasure is sought for its own sake, detached from its intended purposes of procreation and the unitive bond between spouses. (CCC 2351) Lust is considered one of the seven deadly sins, (pride, greed, lust, envy, gluttony, wrath, and sloth) capable of leading to other sins such as adultery, and is spiritually harmful because it distorts love and human relationships.

Pope Francis emphasizes that lust is self-centered, seeking immediate satisfaction and control, whereas authentic love is selfless, patient, and oriented toward the good of the other. Lust is a real spiritual battle but the Saints faced it too, and they offer practical, time-tested guidance. Here’s how some saints teach us to fight lust and grow in purity:

1. Guard Your Eyes and Imagination: Saint Augustine of Hippo emphasized discipline of the senses: “Do not let your eyes linger where your heart should not go.” He says that a person has to be intentional with what he or she watches, scrolls through, and dwells on. Redirect your thoughts quickly, don’t negotiate with temptation.
2. Flee Temptation Immediately: Saint Thomas Aquinas taught that lust is best fought not by arguing with it but by escaping it: “In matters of chastity, flight is the victory.” One has to change the environments fast (leave the room, close the app). Don’t test your limits—avoid near occasions of sin.
3. Pray in the Moment of Temptation. Saint Benedict of Nursia says that when tempted, he used to throw himself into prayer and discipline. You can say short prayers: “Jesus, help me,” or “Mary, keep me pure,” and also use sacramentals (e.g., a crucifix or medal) as reminders to turn to God.
4. Practice Mortification and Self-Control: Saint John Paul II taught that freedom comes through self-mastery: “Purity is the glory of the human body before God.” One can begin by fasting from small comforts (food, screen time, bed) to train your will, and build habits of discipline. What you practice daily shapes your desires.
5. Seek Confession and Grace: St. Padre Pio constantly urged frequent confession: “Confession is the soul’s bath.” One should frequent confession; no priests will chase you for confessing daily. Don’t be discouraged by falls. Grace strengthens you over time.
6. Look to Pure Role Models: e.g. Saint Maria Goretti, who chose purity even in the face of violence and forgave her attacker. Always seek the help of Saints. Remember purity is possible and beautiful.
7. Fill Your Life with Better Loves: Saint Francis de Sales; taught that the heart must be filled with good, not just emptied of bad: “A heart occupied with God has no room for sin.” Always keep busy with meaningful work, service, and prayer, build friendships and habits that lead you toward holiness.
8. Other ways:
Make a list of reasons to resist: I want to wait on having sex until I’m married, because sexual intimacy is sacred and special to me.” “I’m trying to resist temptation because I want to be faithful to my spouse.” “Self-discipline is an important part of my spiritual beliefs. I want to improve my relationship.” “I don’t want my unwanted sexual urges and behaviors to damage my relationships or cause problems in my professional life.”

Know the moment you always fall for lust: e.g. stressed out or bored, around certain people or in specific places (like at the beach or in a bar)? Do something to make you busy. Strengthen your relationship. If you are married, be faithful to your partner, if you are priests or religious, strengthen your relationship with God because you are married to Christ and to the church. Spiritual direction: seek spiritual guidance with your priest or religious leader. Be open to him, he will help you.

N.B. It’s completely normal to experience lust, or sexual desire. Your feelings might be focused on a particular person. But sometimes, these desires can be overwhelming or unwanted. The battle against lust is not won in one moment but through daily choices, grace, and perseverance. Pray over it and learn self-control.

Mary's Journey - Theotokos

Mary's Pregnancy in weeks 22-24.



Mary's little one has achieved a big milestone: breaking the 1-pound mark and gaining steadily now at a rate of about 6 ounces per week. Much of that weight comes from growing organs, bones, muscle, and accumulating baby fat. Growing from the size of a sweet potato to an ear of corn during this time.



Mary may be noticing more changes to her body, including a protruding navel and possibly even slightly bigger feet. She will be in month 6 at the end of these three weeks.

Mary's body may start practicing for delivery. These early irregular muscle squeezing sensations most likely are Braxton Hicks contractions.
