



Phase II Mortgage Pledges



The feast of the Presentation of the Lord occurs February 2nd which is 40 days after Christmas. This year it falls on a Sunday so we will not have the 4th Sunday of Ordinary time readings.

The Jewish tradition is that a child shall be presented in the Temple 40 days after birth. It is called Candle Mass or Candlemas Day as it is also the tradition that parishioners bring their candles to be blessed.

February 3^{rd} is the Feast of St. Blaise. We will bless throats at the February 1^{st} and 2nd after Masses.

St. Blaise, is best known as the patron saint of people with sore throats. On this day, in many places, people gather in churches for the blessing of throats. It can perhaps be assumed that St. Blasius was a bishop and that he suffered martyrdom at the beginning of the fourth century. According to the legend Blasius was a physician at Sebaste before he was raised to the episcopal see. At the time of the persecution under Licinius, he was taken prisoner at the command of the governor, Agricolaus. The hunters of the governor found him in the wilderness in a cave to which he had retired, and while in prison he performed a wonderful cure of a boy who had a fishbone in his throat and who was in danger of choking to death. After suffering various forms of torture St. Blasius was beheaded.

Using two crossed and unlighted candles, the priest (or other minister) touches the throat of each person, saying: *Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from all ailments of the throat and from every other evil:* + *in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.*



A Lenten Retreat

March 13-16, 2025

This retreat invites you into a deepening of relationship with God as you enter the Lenten journey. These

three days of prayer and reflection will center on God's meeting Abram and three of His Apostles *as they are*. No pointing of Divine Fingers but more the invitation to experience God's fidelity to our human fears and questions. It is not a focus of changing our behavior, rather time will be spent in *being* who we are in God's loving gaze rather than preparing to do what we *should*. It is a preached retreat with Fr. Larry Gillick that will include opportunities to celebrate the Eucharist, meet with a spiritual director and participate in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Meals as well as the rest of the day will be in *prayerful silence*.

The retreat cost is based on single occupancy and includes meals—\$425 Check in Thursday between 3:00—5:00 p.m.






