
#### Live The Liturgy Inspiration of the Week

This is Corpus Christi weekend. The Eucharist is central to our faith. At the last Supper we believe that Jesus took bread, broke and said, *"Take and eat this is my body."* And then he took the cup and said, *"Take and drink this is my blood."* We believe in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. The Gospel of John, chapter 6, is very direct about the necessity of believing in the real presence.

I cannot speak for all priests, but for me, celebrating the Mass is a highpoint of my day. It is humbling to be called to serve God and the people of God in this way. The devotion to the Eucharist in Prince of Peace is very strong. If you have a chance, take some time and sit in front of the Blessed Sacrament. You will find it to be an uplifting experience.

June is the traditional month for marriage; however, couples get married any month of the year. We have many weddings at Prince of Peace. In order to receive the sacrament of marriage, couples must participate in marriage preparation. During these sessions with a priest, deacon, or a married couple, the topics deal with life issues and how the couple to be married deal with these issues. We work on communication skills.

It is said that marriages are made in heaven...but I say they are lived out and worked out here on earth. As I work with couples, I encourage them to base their marriage on the loving relationship God has with us. I encourage them to pray together, pray as a family, and attend Mass every week. It is not only a saying, "the family that prays together stays together." Statistics have shown that marriages are stronger with prayer and divorces are fewer.

Forgiveness is also a big part of marriage. There is another saying: "People marry each other because they are perfect and then spend the rest of their lives trying to change their spouse." We are not perfect people. As the Lord's prayer instructs us, we are called to forgive one another as Christ has forgiven us. Forgiveness is key to a successful married life.

Finally, to keep your marriage alive through healthy times with your spouse, love, laugh, pray, and play together.










#### THE LEGION OF MARY HAS A NEW Rosary Crusade.
