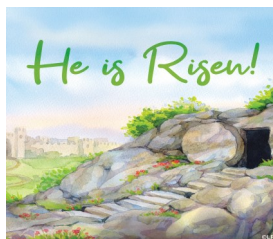

Nebraska Catholic Day of Giving May 6th

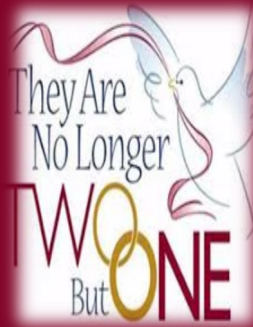

Know your faith. WHAT HAPPENS IN HEAVEN WHEN YOU PRAY THE ROSARY?

Did you know that the month of MAY and OCTOBER are the two months dedicated to Our Lady? As we begin this month of May, I will give you some reasons why the rosary is one of the most powerful prayers we do not want to take for granted.

The Rosary is one of the **most loved prayers in the Catholic Church**. For centuries, saints, Popes, and mystics have praised it. Yet many people still wonder what really happens when someone prays it. Is it just repetition, or does Heaven truly notice? According to Scripture, the saints, and the long tradition of the Church, your Rosary prayers do not stay on earth. Something deeper is happening.

1. Your Rosary Rises Before God: When you pray the Rosary, your prayer rises before God's throne. Revelation 5:8 gives a powerful image: "The four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb. Each had a harp and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints." Your prayers are like incense before God. Every Hail Mary, every Our Father, even the Rosaries prayed while tired or distracted, are gathered and presented before Him. None of them are wasted.

2. Mary Receives Each Prayer Like a Rose: The word Rosary comes from rosarium, meaning a garden or crown of roses. Catholic tradition teaches that each Hail Mary is like a spiritual rose offered to the Blessed Virgin Mary. St. Louis de Montfort wrote: "When you say your Rosary, the angels and saints join with you in it and unite their prayers to yours." Mary receives these prayers with a mother's love and presents them to Jesus. What seems small on earth becomes something beautiful in Heaven.

3. Angels and Saints Join the Prayer: When you pray the Rosary, you are not praying alone. The Communion of Saints surrounds the Church. The angels hear the same greeting Gabriel spoke to Mary: "Hail, full of grace" (Luke 1:28). The saints who loved the Rosary during their lives now join their prayers with yours. Saints like St. John Paul II, St. Padre Pio, and St. Louis de Montfort leaned heavily on this prayer. When you take up the beads, you step into that same stream of prayer.

4. The Mysteries Draw You into Christ's Life:

The Rosary is not just words. It is a meditation on the life of Jesus. The Annunciation, the Crucifixion, the Resurrection. Each mystery leads the heart deeper into the Gospel. The Catechism explains this kind of prayer: "Contemplation is a gaze of faith, fixed on Jesus. 'I look at Him and He looks at me.'" (CCC 2715). When you meditate on these mysteries, you are quietly placing your heart before Christ.



5. Graces Flow Back to Earth: The Rosary has long been linked to conversion, protection, and peace. This is why Our Lady of Fatima told the children again and again: "Pray the Rosary every day for peace in the world." We often do not see the results right away, but grace moves in ways we cannot measure. Hearts soften. Souls return to God. Strength is given to the suffering and the dying. Your Rosary may be helping someone you will never meet on this side of eternity.

6. Even a Distracted Rosary Matters: Many people worry that their Rosary is not perfect. The mind wanders. Focus slips. But God sees the effort of the heart. St. Louis de Montfort once said: "A single Hail Mary, said Well, shakes all of hell." Even a Rosary prayed imperfectly, but with faith, is precious before God.

N.B. "When you pray the Rosary, far more is happening than you can see. Your prayer rises before God. Mary receives it with love. Angels and saints join in. Christ pours grace back into the world. Even your weakest Rosary is noticed in Heaven. That is why so many saints clung to it, especially in difficult times. St. Padre Pio once said: "The Rosary is the weapon for these times."

Join us each Thursday at 7pm to pray the rosary together in the social hall of Prince of Peace parish.

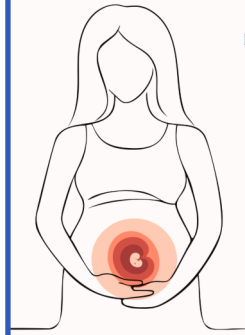
