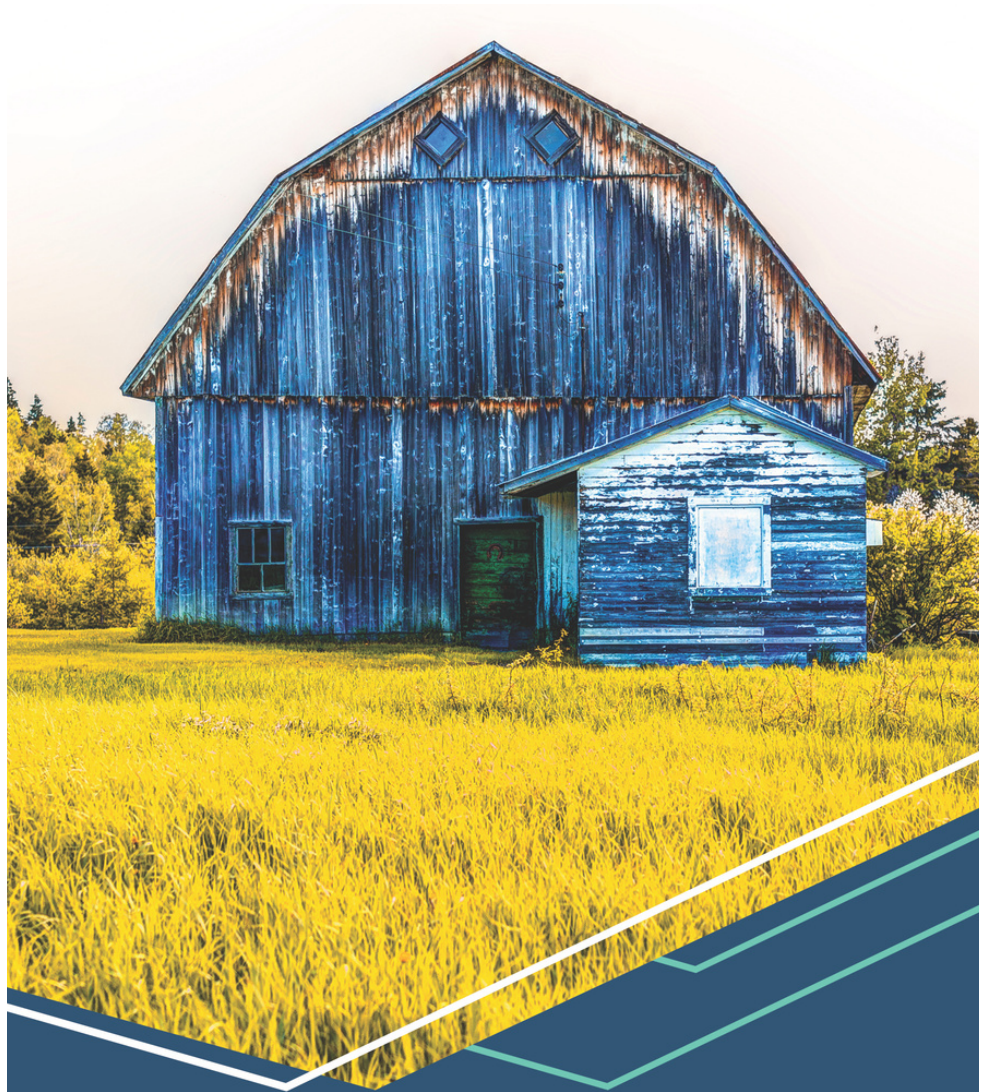
### **FR. SCOTT HARTER**

# CATHOLIC PRAYER POSTURES & GESTURES

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Gestures and postures in the liturgy are essential expressions of reverence, unity, and active participation in the Mass, guiding both the faithful and ministers in prayerful and communal worship. Catholic prayer postures change during Mass for a reason in that they express devotion, reverence, and spiritual focus, linking body and soul in worship.

## COMMON POSTURES AND THEIR MEANINGS:

**STANDING:** Standing is a posture of respect, readiness, and attentiveness. Catholics stand during key parts of the Mass, such as the Gospel reading, the Creed, and prayers of the faithful, symbolizing honor for God and active participation in the liturgy (Mark 11:25, Jesus instructs, "And whenever you stand praying, forgive if you have anything against anyone.")

**KNEELING:** Kneeling represents humility, adoration, and submission to God. It is commonly used during the Eucharistic Prayer and after receiving Communion. Kneeling lowers the body, reflecting spiritual surrender and reverence. It can also be used during private prayers; it is one way of prayer which helps you to concentrate and not to be distracted in prayer. (In 1 Kings 8:54, we find Solomon kneeling before the altar while praying, in Luke 22:41, Jesus kneels in the garden of Gethsemane as he prays before his impending crucifixion.)

**SITTING:** Sitting is a posture of listening, meditation, and reflection. During readings, the homily, and periods of silent prayer, sitting allows the faithful to focus on God's Word and internalize its meaning. In the Bible it often denotes rest and contemplation in God's presence. In 2 Samuel 7:18, King David sits before the Lord in prayer. This posture allows for a welcoming and fostering dialogue, where one can listen intently to God's voice. Jesus also sat down before delivering the sermon on the mountain. (Mat 5:1-2)

**Why we should not sit with legs crossed:** crossing legs can convert in a casual or indifferent attitude, which is out of place during the sacred act of worship. While such posture might be comfortable in everyday settings, during the liturgy it risks detracting from the sense of respect and attentiveness owed to the presence of God and his word.

**PROSTRATION (LYING FACE DOWN):** Prostration is a rare but deeply symbolic posture of total humility and surrender, used during ordinations, Good Friday services, and certain liturgical rites. It signifies sharing in Christ's death and complete submission to God's will. (Revelation 7:11, where angels and elders fall prostrate before the throne of God in worship.) This position embodies the ultimate act of surrender, acknowledging God's absolute authority and glory. It often occurs during times of deep repentance or supplication, reflecting the seriousness of the prayer and the believer's complete submission to God's will.

**BOWING:** It signifies surrendering oneself completely to God, honoring His sovereignty. (Psalm 95:6 proclaims, "Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker.") Bowing can be an outward expression of reverence and adoration; it highlights the acknowledgment of God's greatness over our lives and a willingness to align ourselves with His will.

**ORANS (HANDS RAISED):** The orans posture, with hands extended, echoes Christ's outstretched arms on the cross. Lifting hands is a physical expression of praise and surrender mentioned in several Psalms. Psalm 63:4 "I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name, I will lift up my hands." This position symbolizes an open heart and an eagerness to receive God's blessings. Lifting hands can also indicate joy, celebration, and a desire for closeness with God. It is a powerful posture that reflects both gratitude and longing for divine connection. The Orans posture in liturgy is reserved for the celebrant as he acts in persona Christi, offering prayers on behalf of the congregation. Holding hands during Our Father: Holding hands during liturgy and during Our Father is not prescribed posture in liturgy. While it may appear to foster unity, this gesture is an innovation not rooted in the church's liturgical tradition.

**N.B.1.** In personal or private prayer, Catholics may adopt the same postures to deepen their connection with God. These postures help express devotion, humility, and attentiveness, and can be adapted to the individual's context while maintaining reverence

**The danger of introducing personal gestures into liturgy:** liturgy is the public and communal act of worship, governed by the church's authority. It is not an occasion for individual expression but for collective participation. Personal gestures, while with meaning, risk disrupting the unity and focus of the liturgy. They can create distractions and detract from the sacred symbolism of the prescribed gestures and postures.

**N.B.2.** Catholic prayer postures are more than physical positions; they are expressions of faith that engage the body in worship, enhance spiritual focus, and connect the faithful to centuries of tradition. By standing, kneeling, sitting, prostrating, or raising hands, Catholics embody their devotion and participate fully in the liturgy and personal prayer life

**N.B.3.** During liturgy, we give more respect to God, more than we give to presidents, other officials, or when seeking a job. If you sit and dress up properly before your interviewer for a job or before the president, or at a function, what prohibits one from giving more respect to God who is above all.

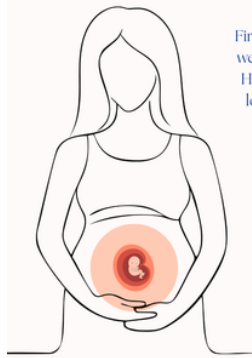

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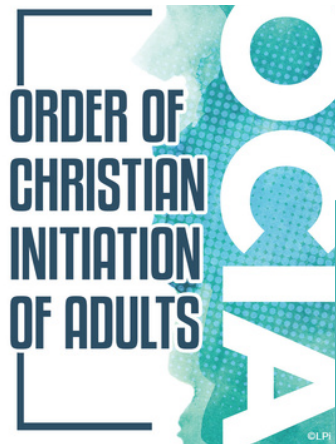

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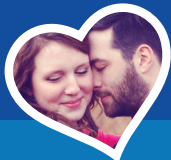
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
