



Wednesday, May 7, we had a May Crowning ceremony at a special 5:30 pm Mass. This was also the closing Mass for our religious formation, K-5, and Edge. The Prince of Peace Knights of Columbus Council served a meal directly following the Mass.

Pastor's note: Last weekend we had 34 young boys and girls make their First Communion. It was a beautiful ceremony. You may see many pictures if you go

to the Prince of Peace Facebook page. Thank you to Amy Lowe for all her excellent work in getting the youth prepared along with her catechists. Also, a big thank you to the parents in working with the youth and helping them understand the Holy Communion and learning their prayers.

For centuries, it has been the custom of Catholics to dedicate the month of May to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The month of May is always part of the Easter season, and part of the fifty days we celebrate in the liturgy the resurrection of our Lord. It is also a time of awaiting the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. The celebration of May as a Marian month fits well with the liturgical celebrations of Easter and Pentecost, as we recall Mary's great joy in her son's victory over death as well as her presence with the apostles in the upper room prayerfully awaiting the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.






