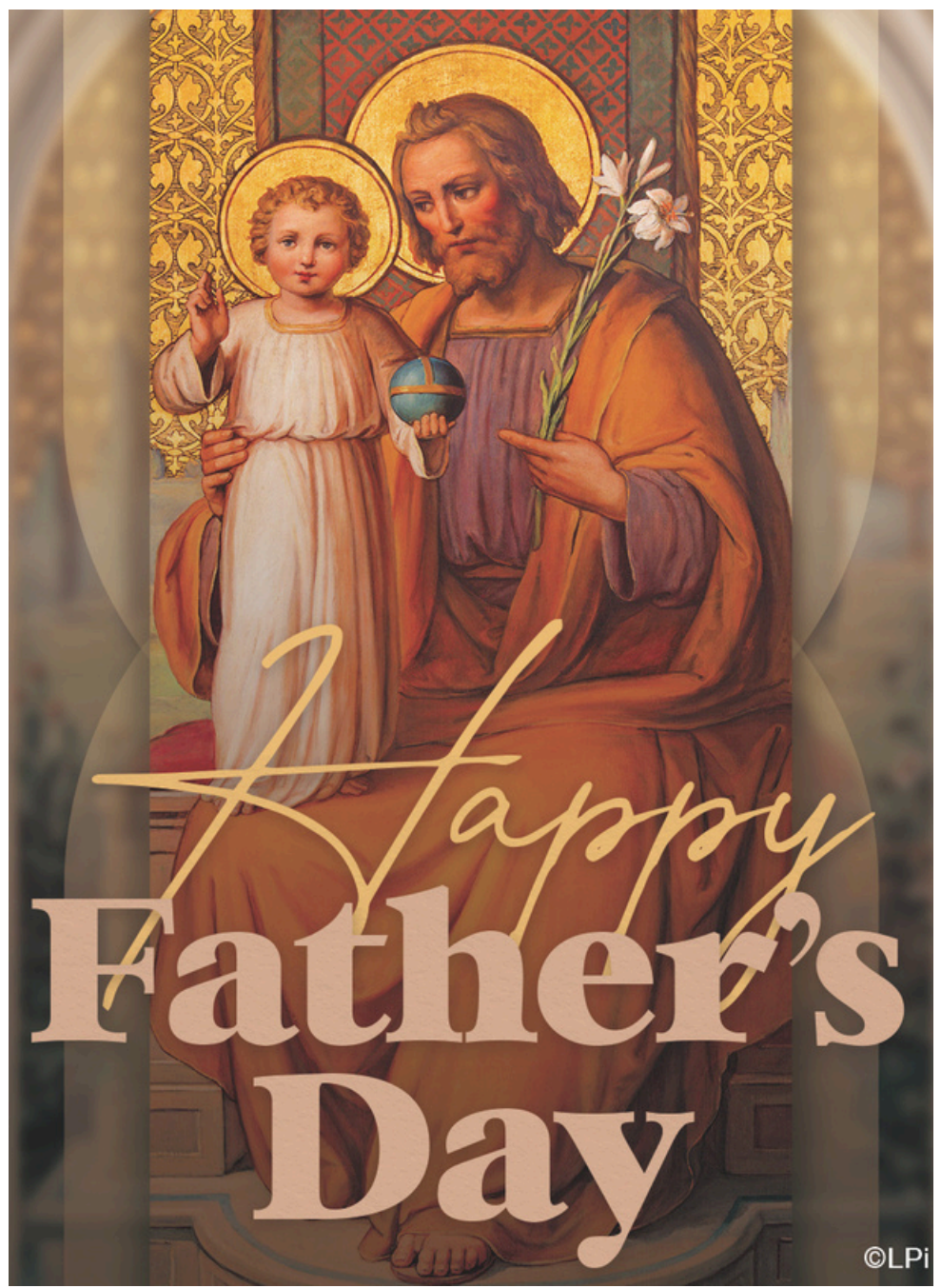
### FR. SCOTT HARTER

# THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK & THE LAST RITES

The sacrament of the anointing of the sick is defined as the sacrament that is given to someone who is sick or has ongoing medical issues. It is an outward sign established or instituted by Jesus Christ during his earthly ministry to bestow inward grace to the recipient, through the power of the Holy Spirit. (CCC 1511; Mark 6:13; Jas. 5:14-15).

**WHO ADMINISTERS IT?** A bishop or priest, through whom Jesus works, administers this sacrament to heal the sick person from sin and sometimes even from physical ailment.

**FROM THE BIBLE:** Mark refers to the sacrament when he recounts how Jesus sent out the twelve disciples to preach and, “they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many that were sick and healed them.” (Mark 6:13) St. James says, “Is any among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save the sick man, and the Lord will raise him up; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.” (Jas. 5:14-15)

**THE EFFECTS THIS SACRAMENT:** It grants special grace to the sick and unites the person to the passion of Christ, giving him or her strength, peace, and courage to endure in a Christian manner the sufferings of illness or old age. It grants forgiveness of sins if the person was not able to obtain it through the sacrament of penance. It can restore health, if it is conducive to the salvation of the person’s soul or can provide preparation for passing over to eternal life, especially to the dying.” (CCC 1532)

**WHEN CAN I RECEIVE THIS SACRAMENT?** As soon as any of the faithful is seriously ill or begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived.” (CCC 1514)

**WHAT ARE “LAST RITES”?** At the moment of death, a Christian is prepared to go well to meet the Lord in heaven, so he or she receives the last rites which gives comfort on his or her final journey. In this late preparation, one receives the last rites of penance (or confession), confirmation (when lacking), anointing of the sick and Viaticum (Latin: that which you take on the road). This special Communion prepares us to travel with the Lord on the final part of our journey. (You can read more about Saint Martin of Tours’ last days when he fought with the devil.)

**DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ANOINTING OF THE SICK AND THE LAST RITES.**

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** The anointing of the sick is not for the dying but for all the sick. For example, when one is having surgery, dealing with a physical, mental, emotional or even spiritual affliction. It is during these difficult times that we need the Holy Spirit's gifts of strength, faith, peace, and courage. It is during these times, as well, that we should seek to receive this God-given Sacrament. Anyone can ask for the anointment when he or she is sick, before surgery, or during any other serious illness. Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present, and sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by this Sacrament.

**LAST RITES - LAST BLESSING:** After the administration of the Sacrament of Anointing, the Last Rites may be given. The Last Rites is an Apostolic Blessing that gives a plenary indulgence to the dying person. The Apostolic Blessing (pardon or blessing) is an indulgence given in situations of danger of death, usually after the absolution of the Sacrament of Penance. The focus is on the remission of temporal punishment due to sin. The church grants permission to the priest administering the sacrament to give this final blessing to the dying.

**HOW MANY TIMES CAN I RECEIVE THIS SACRAMENT?** Unlike other sacraments, this can be administered more than once, especially if a person has a chronic illness, or strange sickness.

**Matter and form of the sacrament:** The matter is anointing with the Oil of the Sick. The form is: “Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord who frees you from sin, save you, and raise you up.”

**N.B.** The Anointing of the Sick can only be administered to the living and not to the dead. And not to animals. Sacraments are celebrated and administered only with and to the living.



Mary's Pregnancy in weeks 13-15.



At Mary's ultrasound she may be able to find out that she is having a boy. His vocal cords are starting to form, preparing him for crying and cooing. His facial muscles can be used now to grimace and smile.

During these weeks Baby will grow from 3 inches to around 4 inches. Week 14 starts Mary's second trimester. At 15 weeks He will be the size of a pear.

Mary may start feeling less nauseous, find it hard to remember things, or easily catch a cold or infection. She also may be starting to show she is pregnant.

Keeping track of things on a calendar or phone can help Mary stay organized and less forgetful. Carrying hand sanitizer and washing her hands often will help her stay healthy.

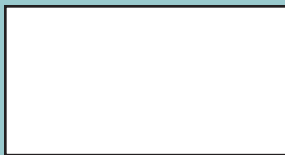
