A Taizé prayer service is a peaceful, contemplative gathering featuring simple, repetitive songs (chants), Scripture readings, and long periods of silence, designed to foster a meditative encounter with God through simplicity and community.

Supporting Catholic Education at Kearney Catholic

Kearney Catholic High School is sustained through a partnership of families, parishes, and the broader community. Teacher salaries and insurance account for 68% of the operating budget. Since establishing the Annual Star Fund in 2022, teacher base salary has increased from 83.4% to 88.5% of Kearney Public Schools' base salary, helping strengthen stability in the classroom. This March, through Match Madness, a generous donor will match gifts dollar-for-dollar up to \$50,000 in support of teacher salaries. Do you have a green thumb or enjoy working on landscaping projects? The Prince of Peace Building and Grounds Committee is currently in search of a volunteer/s who would like to assume responsibility for our beautiful landscape. Duties would include seasonal maintenance of the flower beds and managing plans and updates to the surrounding grounds. This might be a great opportunity for a husband and wife team that enjoys outdoor activities such as this.

You may have realized our church has a monstrance with our Lord on the altar every Thursday and Friday. Do you know what is happening? Do you know that you might be missing a treasure in your life if you have not been there?

The answer is here!! Let us begin by explaining a little about everything:

a. Exposition: The Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is a specific form of Eucharistic Adoration. During the Exposition, the consecrated Host of the Body of Christ is displayed for adoration in a monstrance or ostensorium, and is often accompanied by hymns, prayers, scripture reading, and silent reflection. This practice typically takes place in a church where the Eucharist is placed on the altar, surrounded by candles and flowers. It is a time for prayer and reflection, focusing on the presence of Christ in the Eucharist. During this time, individuals may offer prayers, engage in silent contemplation, or participate in formal devotions such as the Rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet.

b. Adoration: Eucharistic adoration is a time for prayer in which Christians, particularly, the Catholic faithful, adore our Lord Jesus Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament. Adoration can take place either when the Church reserves our Eucharistic Lord Jesus in the tabernacle, or when a priest exposes the consecrated Host in a monstrance outside of Mass. This type of worship logically flows from the Catholic dogma that Jesus is truly and sacramentally present in the body, blood, soul, and divinity of the Eucharist; in this case under the appearance of bread in the consecrated Host.

c. Benediction: After the time of adoration comes benediction, when the priest or deacon, and also the faithful, join in singing a hymn and offer other prayers. During benediction, those gathered traditionally sing Tantum Ergo, a hymn which Pope Urban IV had St. Thomas Aquinas wrote for the celebration of Corpus Christi. After the hymn, the faithful remain kneeling while the priest or deacon incenses the Eucharist if exposition has taken place with a monstrance. After this, the ordained minister will raise the monstrance and Christ bless the faithful gathered in the form of the Blessed Sacrament, making the sign of the cross over them.

d. Holy hour: The practice of spending an hour in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament has its roots deeply embedded in the spirituality of the Church, offering a time for reflection, adoration, and communion with God.

Why the exposition in the MONSTRANCE? To see Jesus visibly present under the appearance of the consecrated host is much more conducive to intimacy than hidden

away in the tabernacle. Moreover, it adds an extra responsibility on the adorers to be sure to be faithful to the hours they are scheduled, since the suggested norm for having Jesus exposed in the monstrance is that there should be at least two adorers present, and He must never be left alone. These are the words of the Lord himself: **"Indeed, this is the will of My Heavenly Father, that everyone who looks upon the Son, and believes in Him, shall have eternal life. Him I will raise up on the last day."**



WHY SHOULD I GO FOR ADORATION?

This is a personal invitation to you from Jesus; Jesus is counting on you because the Eucharist is the center of life. Your hour with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament will repair evils of the world and bring about peace on earth. Day and night Jesus dwells in the Blessed Sacrament because you are the most important person in the world to him! Jesus wants you to do more than to go to Mass on Sunday. You grow spiritually with each moment you spend with Jesus! The best time you spend on earth is with Jesus, your best friend, in the Blessed Sacrament! Just as you can't be exposed to the sun without receiving its rays, neither can you come to Jesus exposed in the Blessed Sacrament without receiving the divine rays of his grace, his love, his peace. If Jesus were actually visible in church, everyone would run to welcome him, but he remains hidden in the Sacred Host under the appearance of bread, because he is calling us to faith, that we may come to him in humility. If the pope himself would give you a special invitation to visit him in the Vatican, this honor would be nothing in comparison to the honor and dignity that Jesus himself bestows upon you with the invitation of spending one hour with him in the Blessed Sacrament.

How does one spend an hour before Jesus exposed in the Blessed Sacrament?

This hour Jesus wants you to spend with Him is spent any way you want. You may bring your own prayer books, use the books in the chapel, read the Bible, pray the rosary, or just sit and relax and enjoy the sweet peace that comes from simply being in the Presence of God. You may feel that you can't pray well. Don't let this discourage you. The mere fact that you take time out at a specific time each week to spend an hour with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament pleases Him very much and is in itself a prayer of great faith.




