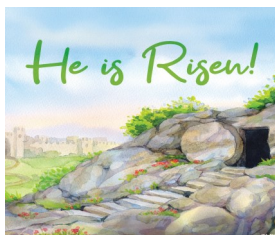

### Join the Prince of Peace Video & Podcast Team!

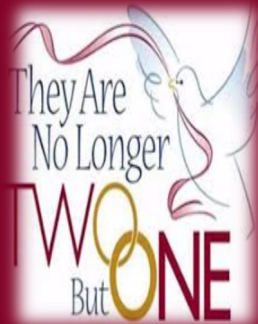

**Know your faith. WHAT HAPPENS IN HEAVEN WHEN YOU PRAY THE ROSARY?**

Did you know that the month of **MAY** and **OCTOBER** are the two Months dedicated to Our Lady? As we begin this Month of May, I will give you some reasons why the Rosary is one of the most powerful prayers we do not have to take for granted.

1. **It is Physical.** When we pray the Rosary, we use our bodies. We hold the Rosary beads so it becomes communicative and not boring, that is why sometimes we do it either walking, kneeling or sitting attentively.
2. **The best healing mysteries:** Where there are bad memories, they are healed. Where there are wounds, Doctor Jesus and Nurse Mary minister to our needs. The Rosary is a powerful weapon against evil and other challenges. Satan fears the Rosary, it intimidates him, it is one of the ways you can get rid of addictions, the best prayer ever.
3. **Spiritual Warfare is Engaged.** Satan hates the Rosary. He hates Mary. He hates the Gospel. He hates God. He hates Christ the Lord. He hates the Lord's Prayer. He hates the Hail Mary. He hates you. Every time you pray the Rosary, you are entering the territory that Satan wants to claim as his own. He wants control over your will. He wants control over your speech. You take that from him. He wants control over your imagination. You take that from him. He wants control over your emotions and your early life. You take that from him.
4. **Focus on prayer & it Rids us from Distractions:** When people come to the Lord to pray, they sometimes have deep burdens they're carrying. Pray the Rosary with specific prayers associated with

certain beads helps people clear their minds and prepares them to have an experience with God. By focusing on the Lord, we get closer to him, and God desires our fellowship.



5. **The Battle Against Evil in the World Opened.** The mysteries of the Gospel bring alive Christ's victory over Satan, and by praying the Rosary we can apply those victories against Satan's work in the world.

6. **Helps us Reflect.** The Rosary is the best way to meditate upon the life of Jesus, from his birth, life lived, suffering and gives us a great image of eternal life. When we take the time to reflect on Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, we also reflect to see God's transformative power in our lives. Reflection allows us to recall the mistakes of our past but look forward with hope to the future.

7. **Pray for Special Needs:** Praying the Rosary also helps us to bring any special needs to the Lord. This could be anything from someone's friend to a relative and anything in between. This is also the time when we bring forth our own needs to the Lord. God wants us to tell him our needs as well. He knows everything before we even speak a word. He wants us to bring our needs to him and wait patiently as God works on our behalf.

8. **Comfort.** The Rosary is comforting in that it has a system as to how it is prayed. Catholics understand that although they may want to talk to God on their own, the rosary is a tool to get them started back on the track toward contemplative prayer.


