

#### **Catholic Community Food Pantry at Prince** of Peace Church

In January, 6 utility bills were paid for a total of \$625.00 and 4 families were

provided rental assistance for a total of \$575.00. A total of 55 families came for food assistance which is 22 more than in December. This fed 201 family members. We spent a total of \$1,801.83 on groceries and hygiene items to stock the pantry.

In February, 7 utility bills were paid for a total of \$650.00 and 5 families were provided with rental assistance for a total of \$550.00. A total of 35 families came for food assistance. This fed 101 family members. We made trips to the store for food, spending a total of \$610.16 for groceries and hygiene items. We shut the pantry down twice for bad weather.



At this time KCHS and the parishes are working on their respective budgets for the next fiscal year (July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026). As with all organizations, employees are vital to having a dynamic organization.

If you are employed, you understand this and want a the parishes. We depend on your tithing in order to pay a just wage. The cost of living has gone up approximately 3%. Thus, if possible, the employees might expect a raise in portion to the cost of living. This doesn't always happen. And usually, Catholic organizations are not able to pay the same as civil organizations. So, I ask you to pray about your tithe. If possible could you raise it by 3%?

All and all, Prince of Peace parishioners have been very generous not only in tithing to the church, but making sure Prince of Peace pantry is well stocked. You have also supported the many campaigns in the community. I am so grateful that we are over half way toward paying off our debt. So, thank you, thank you, thank you!

So many of you are so involved in the parish already which helps to make our parish so dynamic and alive. All we do and all we say is to give Glory to God! May His name be praised!


