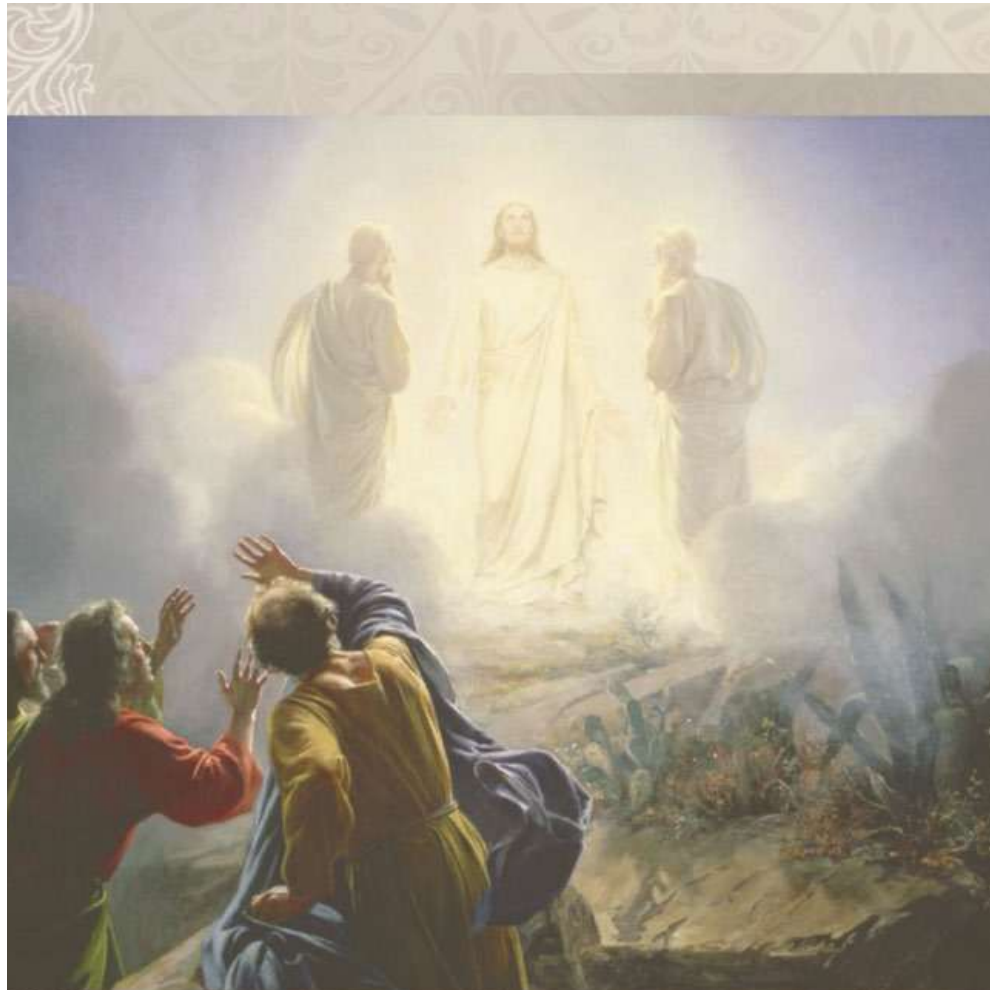

Catholic Community Food Pantry at Prince of Peace Church

In January, 6 utility bills were paid for a total of \$625.00 and 4 families were provided rental assistance for a total of \$575.00. A total of 55 families came for food assistance which is 22 more than in December. This fed 201 family members. We spent a total of \$1,801.83 on groceries and hygiene items to stock the pantry.

In February, 7 utility bills were paid for a total of \$650.00 and 5 families were provided with rental assistance for a total of \$550.00. A total of 35 families came for food assistance. This fed 101 family members. We made trips to the store for food, spending a total of \$610.16 for groceries and hygiene items. We shut the pantry down twice for bad weather.

We are in need of volunteers on the Monday crew, please call the parish office if interested in learning more. The hours are 2-4 PM on Mondays. Thank you for all your Advent calendar gifts this past December. We are greatly supported!

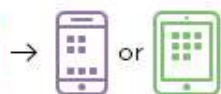

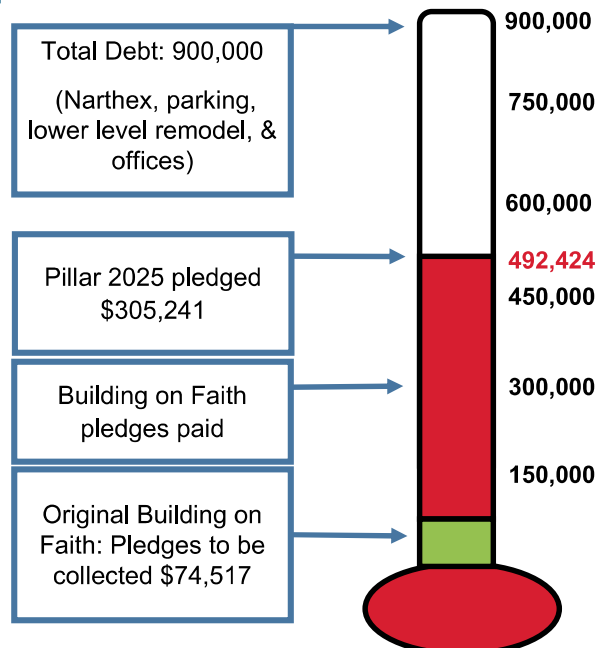

Two weeks ago, February 23rd, we had our **discipleship stewardship renewal**. Many of you have filled out the forms. If you have not, I encourage you to fill out a form and up-date us on your address but also consider making a commitment in one or more of the following areas:

SERVICE: liturgical ministries, council and committees, BBQ and Bazaar, Funeral committee, Social Committee

SHARING: Adult Formation or enrichment, small groups

PARISH SERVICE: Office volunteer, outreach for member of our parish in need, talent sharing, Faith Formation of our youth, Catholic organizations

PRAYING: daily prayer, daily Mass, Eucharistic Adoration

GIVING: prayerfully making a commitment to tithe to the Lord.

At this time KCHS and the parishes are working on their respective budgets for the next fiscal year (July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026). As with all organizations, employees are vital to having a dynamic organization.

If you are employed, you understand this and want a just wage for your work. It is the same for KCHS and the parishes. We depend on your tithing in order to pay a just wage. The cost of living has gone up approximately 3%. Thus, if possible, the employees might expect a raise in portion to the cost of living. This doesn't always happen. And usually, Catholic organizations are not able to pay the same as civil organizations. So, I ask you to pray about your tithe. If possible could you raise it by 3%?

All and all, Prince of Peace parishioners have been very generous not only in tithing to the church, but making sure Prince of Peace pantry is well stocked. You have also supported the many campaigns in the community. I am so grateful that we are over half way toward paying off our debt. So, thank you, thank you, thank you!

So many of you are so involved in the parish already which helps to make our parish so dynamic and alive. All we do and all we say is to give Glory to God! May His name be praised!

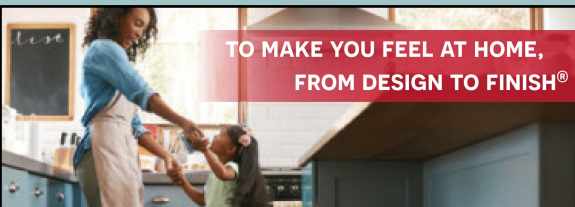
