



A Lenten Retreat

March 13-16, 2025

This retreat invites you into a deepening of relationship with God as you enter the Lenten journey.

These three days of prayer and reflection will center on God's meeting Abram and three of His Apostles *as they are*. No pointing of Divine Fingers but more the invitation to experience God's fidelity to our human fears and questions. It is not a focus of changing our behavior, rather time will be spent in *being* who we are in God's loving gaze rather than preparing to do what we *should*. It is a preached retreat with Fr. 
