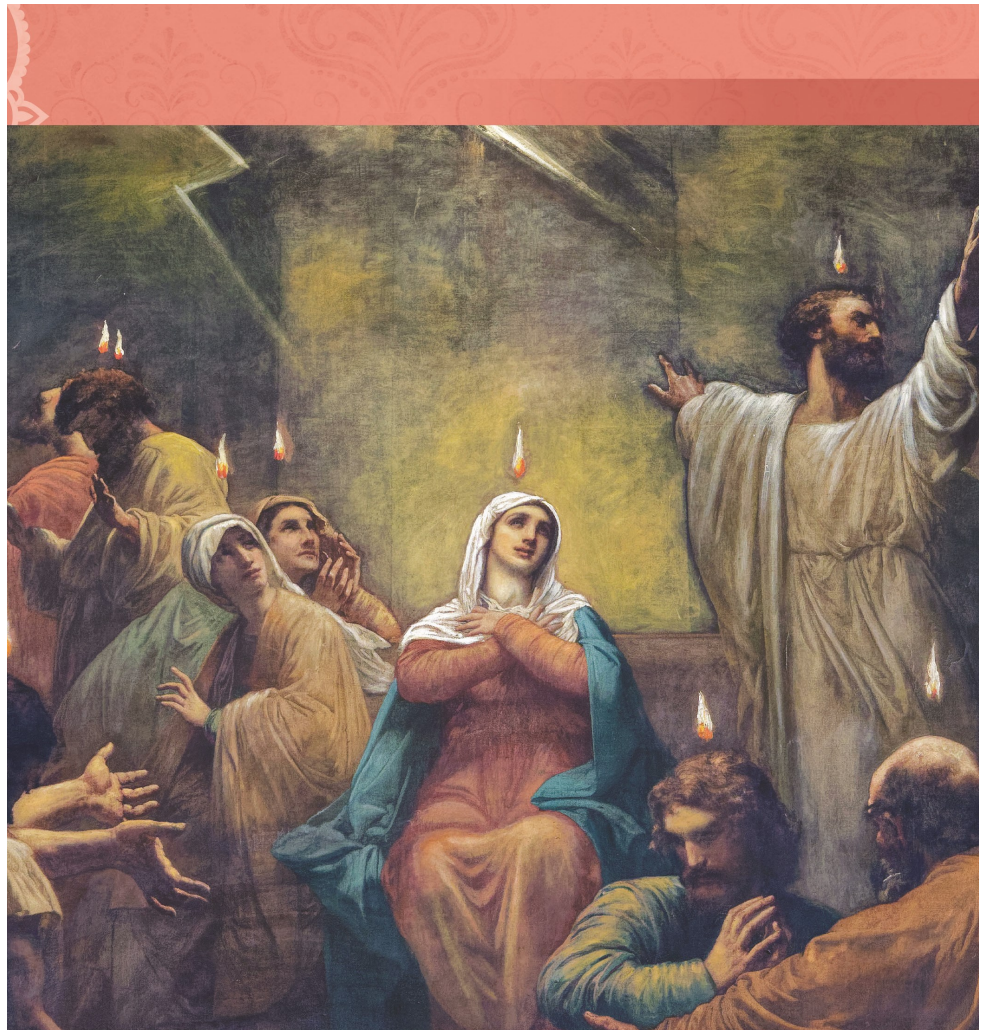
Fr. Scott Harter

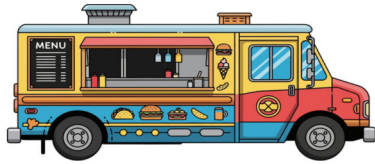

Know your faith: MASTURBATION THE SECRET TOOL OF SATAN WHICH CONTROLS HUMANITY INDIRECTLY.

Many young adults, youths, and elders, have become victims of masturbation, to some it has become an addiction to an extent that people fear to confess it openly. You might be a victim or have a friend who might need help.

We live in a society where sexuality has been trivialized, commercialized and reduced to a mere consumer product. Masturbation is one of the easiest ways to weaken a generation of men **without chains, violence, or force.**

What is masturbation anyway? The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 2352), defines masturbation as "the deliberate stimulation of the genital organs in order to derive sexual pleasure." **The Church teaches** that masturbation is "an intrinsically and gravely disordered action."

Church Tradition and Scripture: St. Thomas Aquinas: In the Summa Theologiae, argued that sexual acts that exclude the possibility of procreation go against the "**natural law**" established by God.

From the Bible it is punishable, God punished Onan to death. (**Gen: 38:9-9.**)

Why is it a sin? The Catholic Church's stance on masturbation is rooted in its understanding of the "theology of the body", the idea that human sexuality has a specific design and purpose. 1. **UNITIVE:** unites the spouse in total self-giving, 2. **PROCREATIVE:** opens to the gift of life. 3. **SPIRITUAL:** reflects God's love for his people. Masturbation is seen as a rejection of **both**, as it is a solitary act. It is individualistic, selfish, unfruitful, and fantasized (always accompanied by lustful thoughts that damage the purity of the heart).

THE PERSONAL AND SPIRITUAL IMPACT:

A: ON A PERSONAL LEVEL: 1. **It drains your physical power and kills your drive;** it generates guilt, anxiety and low self-esteem, **A tired man is easier to control than a focused one.** 2. **IT produces emotional isolation;** by seeking gratification without relationship. Porn + masturbation destroys your focus, discipline, and confidence. Your brain gets addicted to dopamine shortcuts, making real-life goals feel "too hard." A man who can't concentrate can't conquer anything.

B: ON THE SPIRITUAL LEVEL: 1. **Weakness/ destroys the life of grace;** a man disconnected from his spirit becomes easy to dominate. Your sexual energy is life-force; When you waste it, your intuition fades, your clarity disappears, and **your spiritual presence collapses.** 2. **Prayer and communion with God become more difficult;** a drained man: won't fight, won't build, won't question, won't rebel, won't rise. 3. **Enslaved;** it makes one a slave to his Body. You can't build empires with a drained mind and tired spirit. Your greatness requires discipline & not addiction. Our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, **we should not degrade our bodies,** we should respect it and take it as a temple where the lord sits. (1 Cor 6:19-20)

HOW TO OVERCOME MASTURBATION? Every time you choose masturbation over discipline, you hand your power in the hands of the devil, and spiritual blindness. If you don't

control your urges, your urges will control your life and destroy your destiny. Choose strength. Choose clarity. Choose self-mastery. **Your entire future depends on the man you decide to be today.**

HOW TO OVERCOME MASTURBATION:

- **One should pray and fast:** pray the rosary daily, because Our Lady is a mother of purity and victory. Fast and offer your fasting as a prayer.
- **Live a sacramental life:** frequent confession, no priest will chase for confessing this sin. It is the first step in breaking the chains of Satan. Jesus never tires of forgiving us.
- **Guard your senses:** avoid pornography and bad books and novels, it destroys the mind, distorts love, and feeds disordered desires. Control your eyes, limit mobile and internet use.
- **Form your mind and heart:** avail yourself with spiritual readings, read about chastity, seek spiritual direction, surround yourself with good friends and a healthy environment.
- **Accept your human condition:** don't despair when you fall, holiness is not never falling but always getting back up. Offer your struggles for a specific intention.
- **Have Hope;** have hope and be determined, you will overcome, you just have to be patient.

Men: Don't confuse masculine with sexual dominance. The true man is a master of himself. Copy and example of St Joseph, silent and chaste, courageous and protective.

Women: Many Women also struggle silently, but always remember that your dignity does not depend on your purity but purity protects your dignity.

Adults: I know many develop this from your youthfulness; you are not alone. Grace can make all things new. Seek spiritual, and psychological help if needed but do not resign to be victims.

Young People: your body is awakening to many sensations. That is normal, do not let them dominate you. Chastity is not a repression, it is the education of desire towards its true end, which is Love.

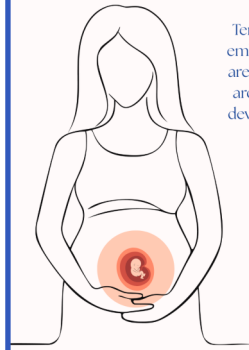

Mary's Journey - Theotokos

Mary's Pregnancy in weeks 10-12.



Terms used for Baby's development change from an embryo to a fetus. At 12 weeks most of Baby's systems are fully formed. The average heart rate at this time is around 150 to 170 bpm. Fingers and toes continue to develop and nails start to form. His bones are starting to form and His muscles start to develop.

Baby grows another inch during these three weeks and will be around the size of a lime by 12 weeks.



Mary may be feeling more tired, may have heartburn and indigestion or experience occasional headaches or dizziness.

Getting some exercise, using pillows to stay elevated while sleeping, and using a cold compress could help alleviate Mary's symptoms.
