I. Committee Reports

1. Finance Report: **Pillars: Building on Faith:** \$3,020,926 has been pledged or donated (Includes 200,000.00 Cope Foundation pledge-over 4-year period) After write offs of \$22,516.50, expected total is \$2,998,409.50. \$2,922,992.39 has been collected. Leaving approximately \$25,417.00 to collect. From parishioners in addition to the final Cope pledge payment of \$50,000 to be paid in Jan of 2026. A total of 356 families participated in this campaign.

Pillars II: Debt payment: \$279,315.90 has been pledged or donated in the one-year pledge. \$139,405.90 has been collected. 130 families have responded to-date.

Mortgage Loans: We have made 4 payments on the \$600,000 Diocesan Loan (3% Interest). Payments are \$10,781.21 each month. We have made 2 months of interest payments toward the Griffiths loan (4.5% interest). These will be \$937.50 this year.

Final MCL bill: The final bill has been paid. The furnace system correction in the lower level room has been made and balanced and the door hinges are installed.

Ordinary Collections: Weekly budget is \$18,500 for the 2024-25 fiscal year.

1st Quarter: Under budget \$31,477.20 2nd Quarter: Over budget \$91,271.24 January: Over budget \$7,730.19 February: under budget \$200.87

Diocesan Appeal (2024-2025): Parish goal \$73,464

Total Raised \$40,492-55%
