National Catholic Schools week is celebrated January 26 to February 1; the theme is, *Catholic Schools: Communities of Faith, Knowledge, and Service.*

One of our parish apostolates is Kearney Catholic High School. The mission of KCHS is "to provide all students a Catholic faith based education to develop academically and spiritually; thereby preparing them to be of service to the church, community, and society."

Due to the great dedication of the parishioners, the administration, teachers, supportive staff, the KCHS foundation, the parish staff, women religious and priests, we can be proud of the fact that this year KCHS has the largest student body in its history: approximately 362 students! This is incredible!

The pastors of Prince of Peace and St. James Parishes are automatically members of the KCHS school board along with the appointed lay board members. The members of the KCH school board from Prince of Peace are Carrie Rasmussen, Joey Cochran, and Sara O'Hare. Representing St. James are Mark McBride, Mike Kathol, and Kristin Ohri. We can appreciate their dedication to assist us in having one of the finest Catholic schools in the area.

I have the privilege of both being educated and teaching in both the public school and the Catholic school systems. While I have an appreciation for both school systems, the freedom to express the Catholic faith in parochial schools is an awesome and marvelous responsibility.

As we celebrate National Catholic Schools week let us give thanks and pray for the dedicated teachers, administration, support staff, volunteers, students and parents who support the Kearney Catholic High School. Let us also give this same praise and thanks to all who, in their words, deeds, and actions, share our Catholic values with those who work at or attend the public schools!

Vocations: Last Tuesday, January 24th, was the Feast of St. Francis DeSalles (1527-1622). He was born of a noble family near Geneva, Switzerland. He was both known for his intelligence and gentleness. He receive a doctorate in law. Nevertheless, he had a passion to serve God and became a priest and later a

bishop. When one studies the lives of the Saints many of them came from the noble families and later the industrial families of the 20th century, like St. Katharine Drexel, who used her sizable inheritance (over 20 million dollars) to found a religious order, the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, to help Native Americans and African Americans.

Parents are the first educators of their children in the ways of faith. The church depends on parents and grandparents nurturing a vocation to the priesthood or religious life. Please encourage your child to consider a vocation to priesthood and religious life (Sister or Brother).

The church is in need of intelligent and gentle candidates like St. Francis DeSalles and St. Katharine Drexel. Being a priest in the 21st century is an extraordinary life. I am grateful to my parents, the Oblates of Immaculate Mary priests and the Dominican Sisters of Kentucky for their examples and inspiration to become a diocesan priest. Please pray with your families for religious vocations.





A Lenten Retreat

March 13-16, 2025

This retreat invites you into a deepening of relationship with God as you enter the Lenten journey. These

three days of prayer and reflection will center on God's meeting Abram and three of His Apostles *as they are*. No pointing of Divine Fingers but more the invitation to experience God's fidelity to our human fears and questions. It is not a focus of changing our behavior, rather time will be spent in *being* who we are in God's loving gaze rather than preparing to do what we *should*. It is a preached retreat with Fr. Larry Gillick that will include opportunities to celebrate the Eucharist, meet with a spiritual director and participate in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Meals as well as the rest of the day will be in *prayerful silence*.

The retreat cost is based on single occupancy and includes meals—\$425 Check in Thursday between 3:00—5:00 p.m.


