

Pastor's note: Thank you for the wonderful celebration of Priesthood Sunday. Thank you to the Serra Club who did much of the work. Thank you for the kind notes and support. This could not have been a better way to prepare for the mini-sabbatical I am taking from October 3 to November 17.

When you read this note I will on the journey to the Institute of Continuing Education of Catholic Priests (ICTE) located on the campus of the North American College in Rome near Vatican City. Above is a picture of the chapel the priests in my program will use for daily Mass.

October 3 I will arrive at the ICTE. It will be a light day with an opening Mass, a lunch with the Rector of the seminary, seminarians, and the priests attending the program. I will give Noah Huddleston, the seminarian from the Diocese of Grand Island and from Kearney your regards. After one day of orientation, the program begins. It is on preaching the Passion of Christ. Most days there will 1 or 2 class sessions a day. This allows the priests to have an opportunity to rest, pray, exercise, study and enjoy not only the beautiful campus of the College but also enjoy the Holy City of Rome.

"Ongoing formation is an indispensable requirement in the life of every priest and in his exercise of the priestly ministry," (The Gift of the Priestly Vocation, IV.56).

Responding to the Church's desire that priests continually enrich their minds in order to more effectively serve their people, ICTE offers a variety of educational programs to fit the schedules of active clergy. The goals of the institute are ongoing human, intellectual, pastoral, and spiritual formation.

More to come as I am writing this September 23. I will be keeping you all in my prayers and remembering you in the Masses I celebrate. This a great gift of time for renewal. I am very grateful! Thank you for the wonderful notes for priesthood Sunday!


