Parable: a story used to teach (specifically used by Jesus)

Mortal Sin: a very serious offense to God. It severs our relationship with Him by destroying grace, which is needed to obtain heaven. **YouCat 315-316**

Venial Sin: a less serious sin or one that involves grave matter but is performed without full knowledge or full consent of the will. Venial sin wounds our relationship with God, but doesn't separate us from Him. **YouCat 315-316**

Apostle: one who is sent on a mission. Jesus chose 12 men whom became close friends for his apostles. **YouCat 92**
