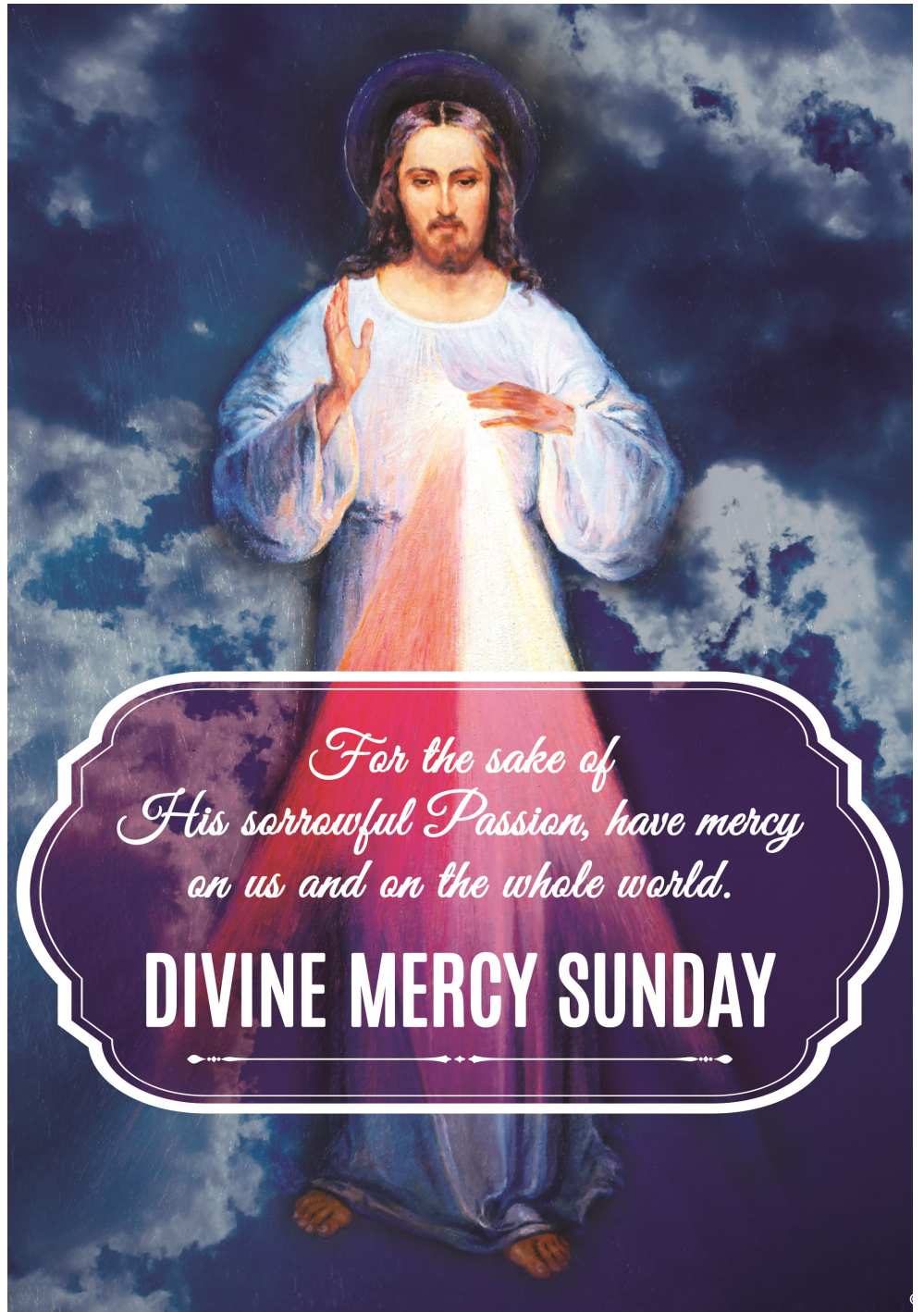

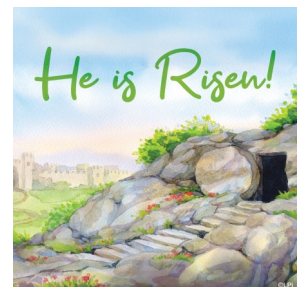

We'll explore the heart of the ancient world—walking through places where Scripture comes alive, visiting iconic ruins, breathtaking landscapes, and vibrant cities.

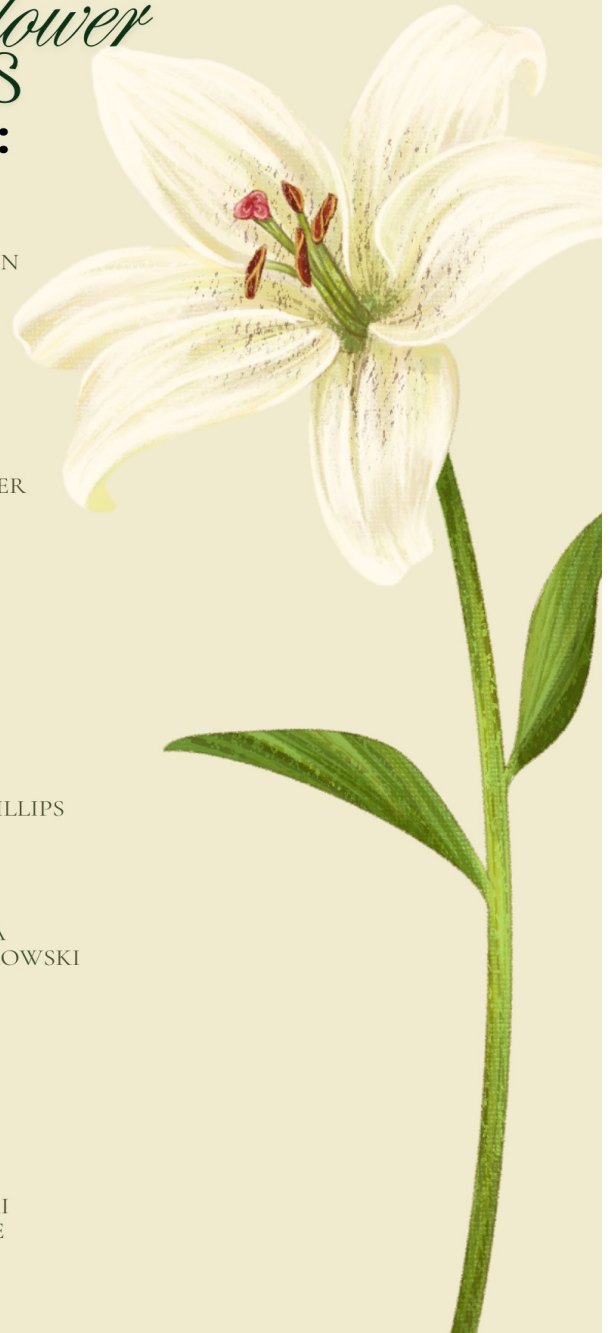

Have you ever thought about the terrible sins we commit, annoying God daily? Do you know that God does not consider them so serious if we run back to him? The Mercy of GOD is eternal and endless! Millions of people look forward to and are profoundly moved by Divine Mercy Sunday.

WHY DIVINE MERCY THEN? Here are some things you need to know!

What is it, and why is it so important? Divine Mercy is a profound devotion that reveals the depth of God's love and forgiveness toward every soul. It is rooted in the private revelations of St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun who recorded her visions and messages from Christ. The devotion emphasizes that God's mercy is infinite and unconditional, and no **sin is greater than His desire to forgive**. Trust in God is the key to receiving His mercy.

What is Divine Mercy Sunday? Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the second Sunday of Easter. In 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina and, during the ceremony, he declared, *"It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this Second Sunday of Easter, which from now on throughout the Church will be called, 'Divine Mercy Sunday.'"*

What do I benefit from Divine mercy? Since God's mercy is stronger than sin, God grants us his Mercy and forgiveness of sins. A plenary indulgence is granted under the usual conditions when one receives a sacrament of confession, Holy Communion and prayer for the intentions of the Pope. One also receives indulgence when on the Divine mercy Sunday recites the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus.

What is the image of the Divine mercy? Jesus is shown in most versions as raising his right hand in blessing, and pointing with his left hand on his chest from which flows two translucent rays, one

red and one white. The depictions often contain the message "Jesus, I trust in You!" The rays streaming out have symbolic meaning: red for the blood of Jesus (which is the Life of Souls), and white for water (which justify souls) (from Diary – 299). The whole image is symbolic of charity, forgiveness and love of God, referred to as the "Fountain of Mercy".

What is the chaplet of divine mercy? The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is a set of prayers used as part of the Divine Mercy Devotion. They are usually said using a standard set of rosary beads, often at 3 p.m. (the time of Jesus' death), but with a different set of prayers than those used in the Marian Rosary.

How did Jesus empower the apostles to forgive or retain sins? And how is it related to the Sacrament of Confession? On the day of Pentecost Christ gave apostles a special empowerment with the Holy Spirit to forgive or retain sins. *"He breathed on them, and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained.'"* (John 20:26) From here, the Church grants priests the power to forgive sins.

The Walking With Moms group is excited to launch *Walking with Mary*. We will take a journey through all nine months of pregnancy by displaying the development of a baby in the womb from the moment of conception to birth.

We began on The Solemnity of the Annunciation (March 25th) and will end nine months later on the Nativity of the Lord (December 25th) when we will host a "Baby Shower". At that time, we will request donated items which will be given to local pro-life organizations.

Mary's Pregnancy in weeks 3-6.



The baby's fingers and toes begin to form, and facial features including the nostril, ears, and jaws begin to take shape.

The baby started off smaller than a grain of rice and is now around 1/8 inch long and the size of a small pea.



Mary may start feeling morning sickness. Some things that may help her feel better are snacking on bland foods and drinking tea.

You can hear the babies heartbeat on an ultrasound. The embryo has a four chamber heart beating around 105 times a minute.
