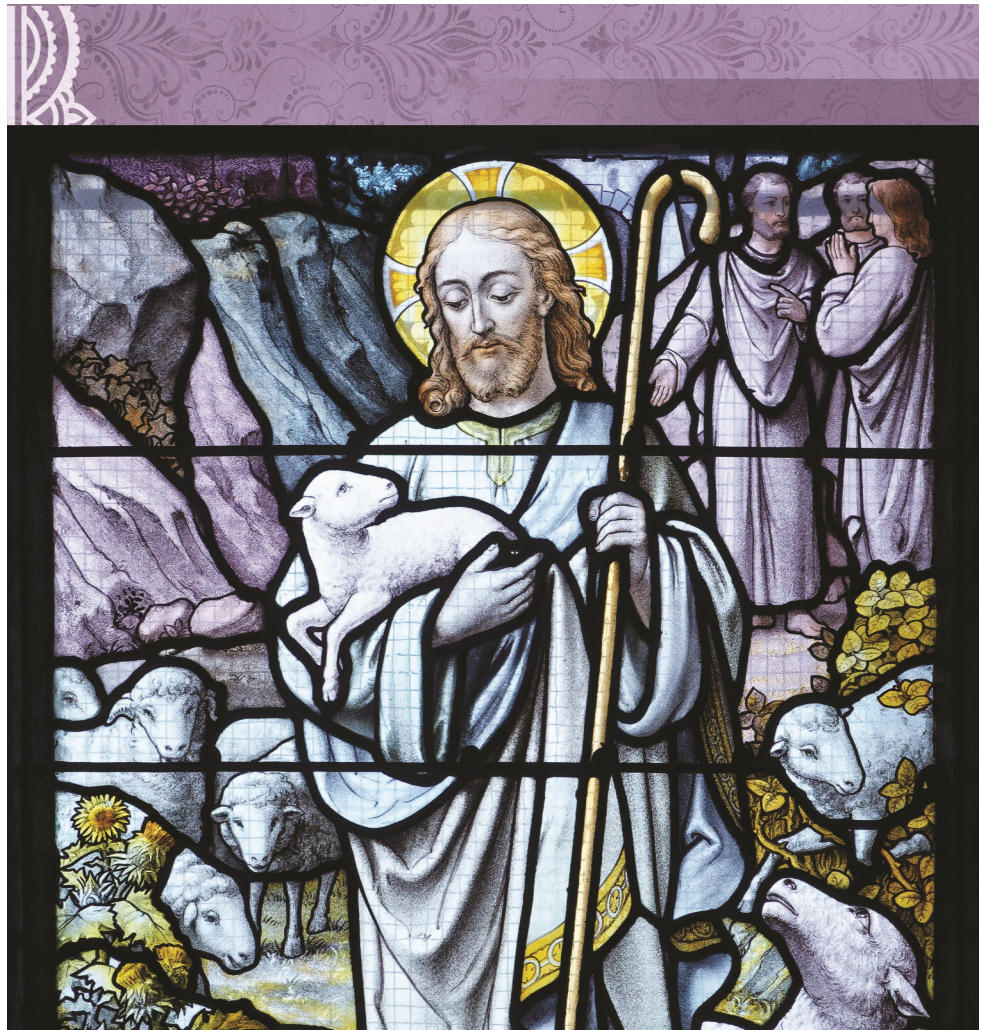
Fr. Scott Harter

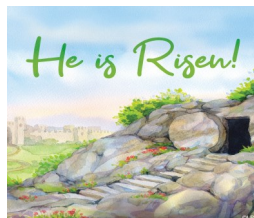

Do you commit sins? Are you forgiven under the sacrament of Penance? Do you think of going to heaven? Or to hell?

When a person dies, the soul goes Either to Heaven or to Hell. Those who go to Hell receive everlasting punishment of fire and agony. But those who go to heaven receive joy and stay with God and the angels. But before the souls go to heaven, they go through a purification so that they meet God when they are totally clean. Those are the souls whose sins were forgiven while on earth but remained with a scar of mortal sin, but those souls purely clean just go straight in heaven (those are the souls who have lived their life of holiness on earth)

What is an indulgence then?

"An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints".

Sin and its gravity. Sin is an offence against reason, truth and right conscience. It is a failure in genuine love for God. Mortal sins cause exclusion from Christ's kingdom.

TYPES OF INDULGENCES and HOW TO GAIN THEM.

1. A partial indulgence is the remission of a portion of the temporal punishment due for sins that have already been forgiven. This can be got even when we receive blessings of our sacramental things, holy water etc

2. PLENARY INDULGENCE: Is a full remission of temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven in the Catholic Church. The practice stems from the Church's authority to bind and loose, as referenced in Matthew 16:19. Plenary indulgences are often tied to particular acts, such as pilgrimages or specific prayers.

JUBILEE YEARS AND INDULGENCES

Jubilee years are significant occasions for plenary indulgences. Rooted in the Old Testament (Leviticus 25:10), jubilees occur every 25 years or on special papal declarations. During these years, the Church opens holy

doors at major basilicas, and pilgrims passing through them can gain indulgences. This year is a **Jubilee year of St Francis of Assisi**

Indulgences for the Souls in Purgatory: Catholics

can apply plenary indulgences to the souls in purgatory; a practice rooted in charity. This is especially emphasized in November, particularly around All Souls' Day (November 2). Visiting a church or cemetery and praying for the deceased can carry a plenary indulgence for the dead. The faithful must meet the usual conditions, including detachment from sin. This act reflects the belief that the living can aid the deceased through prayer (CCC 1032). It also strengthens the communion of saints, linking earth and purgatory. The Church limits the number of indulgences applied to the dead to one per day. This practice encourages regular prayer for the departed. It offers hope that loved ones may reach heaven sooner. The focus on the dead makes plenary indulgences a powerful expression of faith.

Spiritual Benefits: They encourage a deeper commitment to the sacraments, particularly confession and the Eucharist. The requirement of detachment from sin fosters self-examination and repentance. Acts like pilgrimage or prayer draw Catholics closer to God and the Church. Indulgences also promote charity, as seen in their application to the souls in purgatory. The practice reinforces the reality of God's mercy and the hope of heaven. By engaging in indulgenced acts, Catholics grow in holiness and discipline. The communal aspect, tied to the communion of saints, strengthens a sense of belonging. Indulgences are not an end but a means to spiritual maturity. They invite the faithful to live more fully for God.

The gaining of indulgences requires certain prescribed conditions and the performance of certain prescribed works

An indulgence cannot be bought, nor can one be obtained by going through the motions without sincerity.

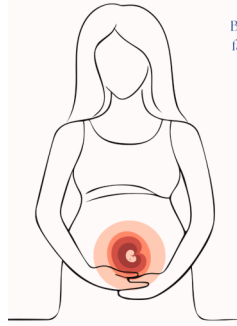

Mary's Pregnancy in weeks 4-6.



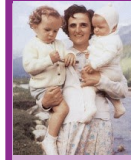
Baby's fingers and toes begin to form, and facial features including the nostrils, ears, and jaw begin to take shape.

Baby started off smaller than a grain of sand and by the end of week 6 is around 1/4 of an inch long and the size of a small pea.



Mary may start feeling morning sickness. Some things that may help her feel better are snacking on bland foods and drinking tea.

At 6 weeks, Baby is still in the embryo stage of development. The heart is forming and Mary can hear and/or see Baby's cardiac activity on an ultrasound.
