Feast of the Baptism of Christ – January 12, 2025

We celebrate the baptism of Christ in the Jordan. This is the second epiphany, or manifestation, of the Lord. The past, the present, and the future are made manifest in this epiphany.

At dusk January 11th, the church begins Ordinary time. At Prince of Peace, we leave up the Christmas decorations until January 12th, to savor the beauty of Christmas a bit longer.

Bishop Joseph Hanefeldt designates the Prince of Peace "Doors of Redemption" as the Jubilee doors for the Kearney Deanery:

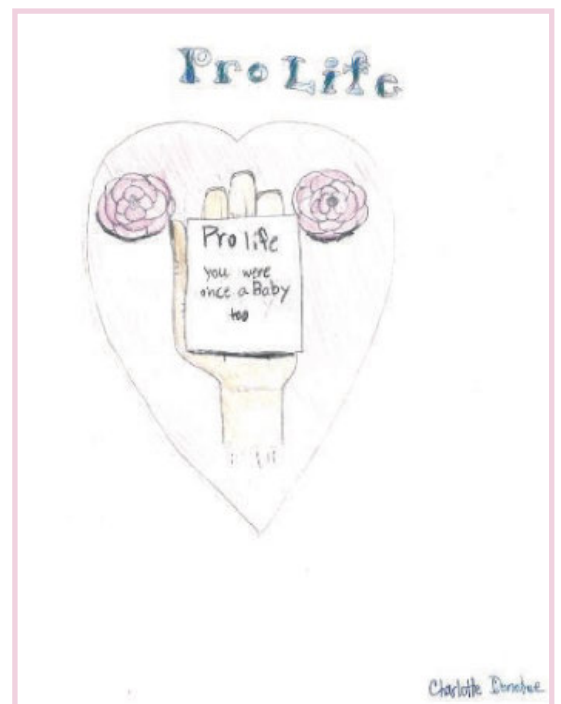




