



their celebration! Stop by the parish hall between 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm on Sunday February 11th and wish Neva well! February looks to be an active month at Prince of Peace parish. First and foremost, we begin the season of Lent with Ash Wednesday. Be prepared to celebrate Valentine's Day before or after the 14th as Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting from food and abstaining from meat. We are asked to only have two light meals and one regular meal this day, and no meat. It is day most people begin their lent renewal or promises.

As always, the Church invites us to embrace the disciplines of Prayer, Fasting, Almsgiving, and **Study.** It is rare that we do not have three meals a day. Many people fast a meal or give up drinking soda or eating sweets during lent. If Bishop in taking care of our Diocese; the people you think about it some people are lucky to have a bowl of rice a day as their only meal. These little sacrifices help us realize that we are so fortunate to have enough to eat and usually, more than enough.

Our Catholic Charities helps so many who are in need of food and financial assistance. Many of you have assisted us with Prince of Peace community pantry which helps so many people in the Kearney area. The church is made up of people like us. When we give alms or tithe, the church can minister to those less fortunate than ourselves.

Both fasting and almsgiving tug on our stomach and our mind to remind us that all is a gift. Lent helps us to focus more on our relationship with our Savior Jesus. Take time to pray more this Lent.

Over the past few years there has been a rediscovery of Worship of the Eucharistic outside of mass or Eucharistic adoration. Every Thursday at 8:30 am to Friday 5 pm we have Eucharist adoration. I have been amazed at the great number of people of all ages who attend. Every Friday during Lent there is an opportunity to sit in the presence of our Savior Jesus. I have found this to be a wonderful way to pray. Why not give it a try?

The parish is offering many opportunities to enrich your Lenten journey. Please consider signing up for our Eucharistic small groups that will be on Mondays starting February 12.

Deacon Thomas Martin is offering a study by Bishop Barron on the Lenten gospels on

Sundays between the Masses.

Stations of the Cross will be offered on Fridays during Lent. A great prayer to meditate on the last steps of Christ.






