





This is the third Sunday of Lent. Many of you have been participating in our Lenten Devotions. Worship of the Eucharist outside of Mass or adoration of the Eucharist is offered from 8 am Thursday until Midnight. It continues on Fridays 8 am until 5 pm. This is great time for you to have some private quiet time with the Lord. Please be mindful that your prayer style might be different than others so let us be patient with each other. It is a regret for us that due to construction issues worship of the Eucharist outside of Mass cannot be offered throughout the night on Thursday. The sacrifice will be worth it when the security system is up and running. I appreciate your understanding!

Every Friday during Lent, Stations of the Cross is offered at 5:30pm. This is another way to remember the great Sacrifice Christ did for us.

The Rice Bowl offering is also part of the Catholic Relief Services project. We will collect your offerings on Palm Sunday. The Church is fortunate to have such generous people such as you. Thank you for all you do for the poor and for your parish.

During Lent, there are a couple of feasts people celebrate. One is St. Patrick's Day, on March 17th. Another is a feast day that many forget, that is St. Joseph's feast day, on March 19th.

Most people are aware of St. Patrick's Day. As many say, "Everyone is Irish on St. Patrick's Day." St. Patrick spent thirty years converting the Irish people from their pagan polytheistic religion of worshipping the sun and moon to Christianity. He died on March 17th, 461 AD.

St. Joseph is honored because he was chosen to be the stepfather of Jesus and the spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He was a carpenter and head of the family. He was declared as Patron of the Universal Church, of workers, and for a happy death. He is often portrayed with a carpenter's square, the infant Jesus, and a staff with lily blossoms.

SpringFest will also soon be here! It is a great community builder for our parish and assists us in making our budget. As advertised, it is our largest fundraiser of the year. So many of you have been selling raffle tickets, donating items, and volunteering. Please consider helping in some way.


