Capital Campaign Update

Great News!

Our \$50,000 matching gift has been fulfilled! Over 260 families have joined in our capital campaign with gifts that total over \$2,157,898.00. The generosity of our members will allow us to improve our facilities and provide more ministry. Our goal is to have 100% of all members of Prince of Peace Parish participate in our capital campaign. Like the "Widow's Mite" all gifts of any size matter because we are all interconnected in living out the Gospel.

Facility Plans

During our capital campaign activities we asked all members to share with us their sense of priorities for our next steps in developing our facilities. There was a high level of consensus among our members. In order, our priorities are: gathering space, renovation of the lower level into classrooms and meeting spaces, parish hall, youth space beneath the hall, and new office space. In order to renovate the lower level we need to move the offices. The plan is to build the new gathering space and offices at the same time, then renovate the lower level. If all goes well we will break ground next year.

March looks to be an active month at Prince of Peace parish. First and foremost we began the season of Lent with Ash Wednesday. As always the Church invites us to embrace the disciplines of **Prayer, Fasting, Almsgiving, and Study**. It is rare that we do not have three meals a day. 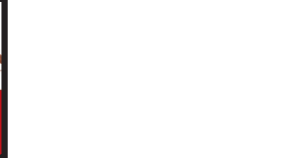
