**Pastor's Notes**

This is the second Sunday of Lent. Many of you have been participating in our Lenten Devotions. Every Thursday and Friday we have adoration of the Eucharist. This is a great time for you to have some private quiet time with the Lord. Please be mindful that your prayer style might be different than others so let us be patient with each other. Every Friday we have the Stations of the Cross at 5:15 pm. This is another way to remember the great sacrifice Christ made for us.

The Rice Bowl offering is part of the Catholic Relief Services project. We will collect your offerings on Palm Sunday. The Church is fortunate to have generous people such as you. Thank you for all you do for the poor and for your parish.

During Lent there are a couple of feasts people celebrate. One is St. Patrick's Day, March 17<sup>th</sup>. Another feast day that many forget is St. Joseph's feast day on March 19<sup>th</sup>.

St. Joseph is honored because he was chosen to be the stepfather of Jesus and the spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He was a carpenter and the head of his family. He was declared the Patron Saint of the Universal Church, workers, and for a happy death. He is often portrayed with a carpenter's square, the infant Jesus and a staff with lily blossoms.

Many more are aware of St. Patrick's Day. As many people say, "Everyone is Irish on St. Patrick's Day." Saint Patrick spent thirty years converting the Irish people from their pagan polytheistic religion of worshipping the sun and moon to Christianity. He died on March 17<sup>th</sup>, 461 AD.

Feast days are used to set aside time to remember the ancestors of our faith, to model their attributes, and to seek their assistance through prayer. These two feast days, which usually fall during Lent, give us a break from the solemnity of Lent, to have a bit of festivity.

On this second weekend of Lent, how are you doing? You can still take time to recommit yourselves to your Lenten promises.
