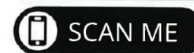

Pastor's Notes

Lent is passing quickly. This would be a great time to examine our Lenten resolutions to see how we are progressing. Remember, progress not perfection. The three disciplines of **prayer, fasting, and almsgiving** are great aids to our conversion.

Prayer: One might ask, "Have I made a conscious effort to pray as I start and end my day? Have I made an effort to attend Sunday Mass and additional daily Masses? Have I attended the Stations of the Cross?"

Fasting helps identify with Jesus' time in the desert. A spiritual discipline helps us to be open to God's voice in our life. One might ask, "Have I tried to fast from a favorite food or drink? Have I tried not eating between meals? Have I fasted from gossiping or using foul language?"

Almsgiving helps to focus on God rather on material things. Almsgiving is part of our Christian tradition to aid the poor. One might ask, "Have I sacrificed my wants to give to the Church or the Rice Bowl to help others?"

Reconciliation: April 3rd, 3:00 pm, at Prince of Peace. There will be several priests available until 4:00 pm. There will not be a penance service. The priests will have stations throughout the church and there will only be individual confessions. Confession is also offered on Wednesdays at 5:00 pm to 5:30 pm.

Holy week begins with Palm Sunday or Passion Sunday on April 10. Please consider wearing red to symbolize Christ's passion. Holy Week should be a week that we avoid participating in extra activities that are not church related.

The Triduum, or the three days, counted from sunset to sunset begin with the liturgy on Holy Thursday, continues on Good Friday and climaxes at the Easter Vigil. Please make an effort to attend. Check the bulletin for the times.

Easter Sunday is a day we all like to dress in our Sunday best to celebrate Christ's Resurrection. We remember Jesus has risen from the dead and he has conquered sin and death once and for all. Please join us for the Easter Sunday Mass. There will be Masses at 6:30 am, 8:00 am, and 10:30 am.

May you have a blessed Lenten Season and Holy Week, and may you have a joyful Easter!

Capital Campaign Information

A committee was formed in 2017 to embark on a long-range planning process for Prince of Peace. They considered the needs of our growing parish and the next possible phase of our facilities. After completion, an all parish survey determined that the priorities of members were: Marriage and Family Life, Faith Formation and Education, Discipleship and Stewardship, and Evangelization. These became the basis for planning and preliminary plans for the next phase.

In June of 2021, the plans were presented to Bishop Joseph Hanefeldt who gave approval for a feasibility study to be conducted. Church Development group launched a study in September of 2021 from which priorities were determined from member input in the following order: 1) New gathering space; 2) Renovate lower level for more early childhood activities, classrooms and meeting spaces; 3) New parish hall with a large kitchen and exterior door for fish fries; 4) Finished space under the new parish hall to serve as youth and adult meeting space; 5) New offices.

Based on the feasibility study, Church development moved forward with a capital campaign; commitment weekend was on December 11th and 12th, 2021. Since that time, 268 families have returned pledge cards with a total of \$2,165,658 pledged. The church also received a bequest \$148,395.15 from the Fr. James O’Conner estate. It is dedicated to the next phase.

The priorities from the feasibility study, as ordered, present a challenge. In order to renovate the lower level into more classrooms, it is necessary to move the offices. It makes sense and would be more cost effective to build new office space next to our new gathering space since they will share electrical, plumbing, and HVAC systems. This means we need to build our least popular section (new offices) at the same time as the most popular section (the gathering space) in order to make way for the renovation of the lower level. In pursuance of avoiding long-term debt, the decision has been made to wait on further plans for a new social hall and youth space at this time.

A gathering space will better serve our church by allowing our ministries to grow and engage our current members. It will provide space for parishioners to visit with each other after Mass, and for visitors to connect with our members. When we renovate the lower level and add new classrooms, we will be making space for a larger group of children so we can better provide for the next generation.

Outside of the capital campaign, other improvements to our church include a new hearing loop that was recently installed and a new sign on 56th Street will go up as soon as details are finalized.
