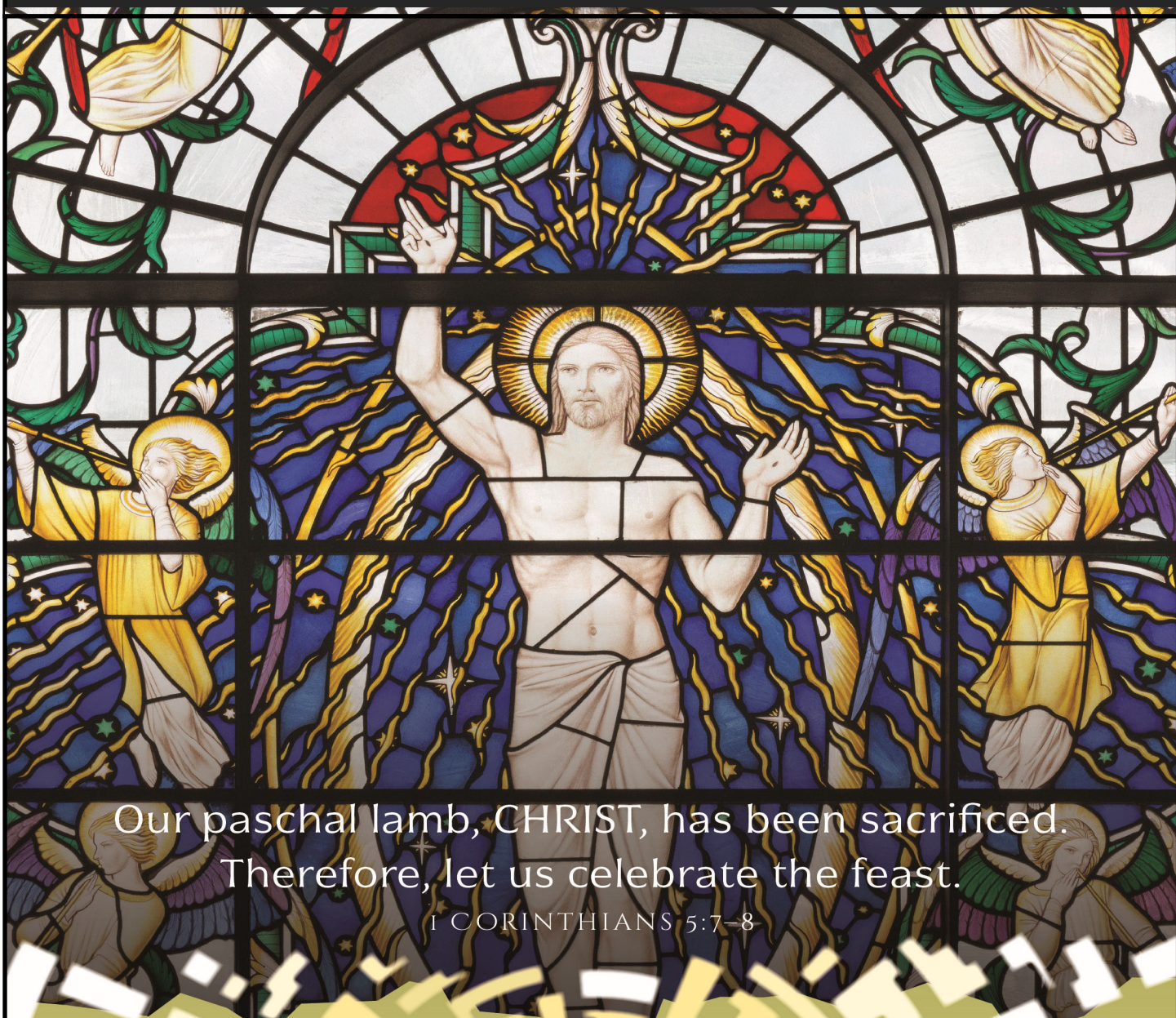

As of the March payment, our building debt is at \$66,500. By the end of June and the completion of this year's pledges, we will only have **\$50,423 left to be debt free** on our parish home.

Five members of the parish committed to making a \$5,000 or more donation toward paying this remaining amount. If only nine more people made an equivalent donation, we would be debt free in July. One way of doing this is for those who have made a dollar commitment "until the debt is paid" to pay off your pledge early.
