

Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia, He has Risen! He has Risen indeed! This is the second Sunday of Easter. It is said that most churches have the lowest attendance this weekend. I have not found that to be the case in the Catholic churches that I have pastored! Praise God!

Anyone who participated in the Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil surely must have been spiritual moved! They were wonderful! Marc Albrecht, Colton Wells, and Karlee Paitz were baptized Saturday night. Brianna Kamler, Mathew Roth, and Brady Holtmeier made a profession of faith and were received into the Catholic church, Darrell Dunham and Freddy Lopez were confirmed. Fr. Lou Nollette truly enjoyed his time! He found the Prince of Peace church to be a wonderful place to preside at liturgy. He found the people who attended to be welcoming, kind, and prayerful. I

A big thank you to all who helped in the planning of the liturgies, the music ministry, the decorating, and all who served at the liturgies as MC's, lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and servers. Your attention to detail made the liturgies incredible!

So let us be mindful that we are called to continue the journey to Pentecost. I encourage you to read the Acts of the Apostles, perhaps the Gospel of Mark, Matthew and Luke. You could also check out the programming on Netflix or Formed.org and watch movies about the early church. We are on a journey

of faith.

**Divine Mercy Sunday**: The second Sunday of Easter is also Divine Mercy Sunday. The devotion was actively promoted by Pope John Paul II. On April 30, 2000, the Canonization of Faustina Kowalska took place and the Sunday after Easter was officially designated as the Sunday of the Divine Mercy in the General Roman Calendar.

On April 22, 2001, which was one year after establishing Divine Mercy Sunday, Pope John Paul II re-emphasized its message in the resurrection context of Easter: Jesus said to St. Faustina one day: "Humanity will never find peace until it turns with trust to Divine Mercy". Divine Mercy! This is the Easter gift that the Church receives from the risen Christ and offers to humanity.

The devotion to Divine Mercy Sunday grew rapidly after its designation by Pope John Paul II and is now widely celebrated by Catholics.




