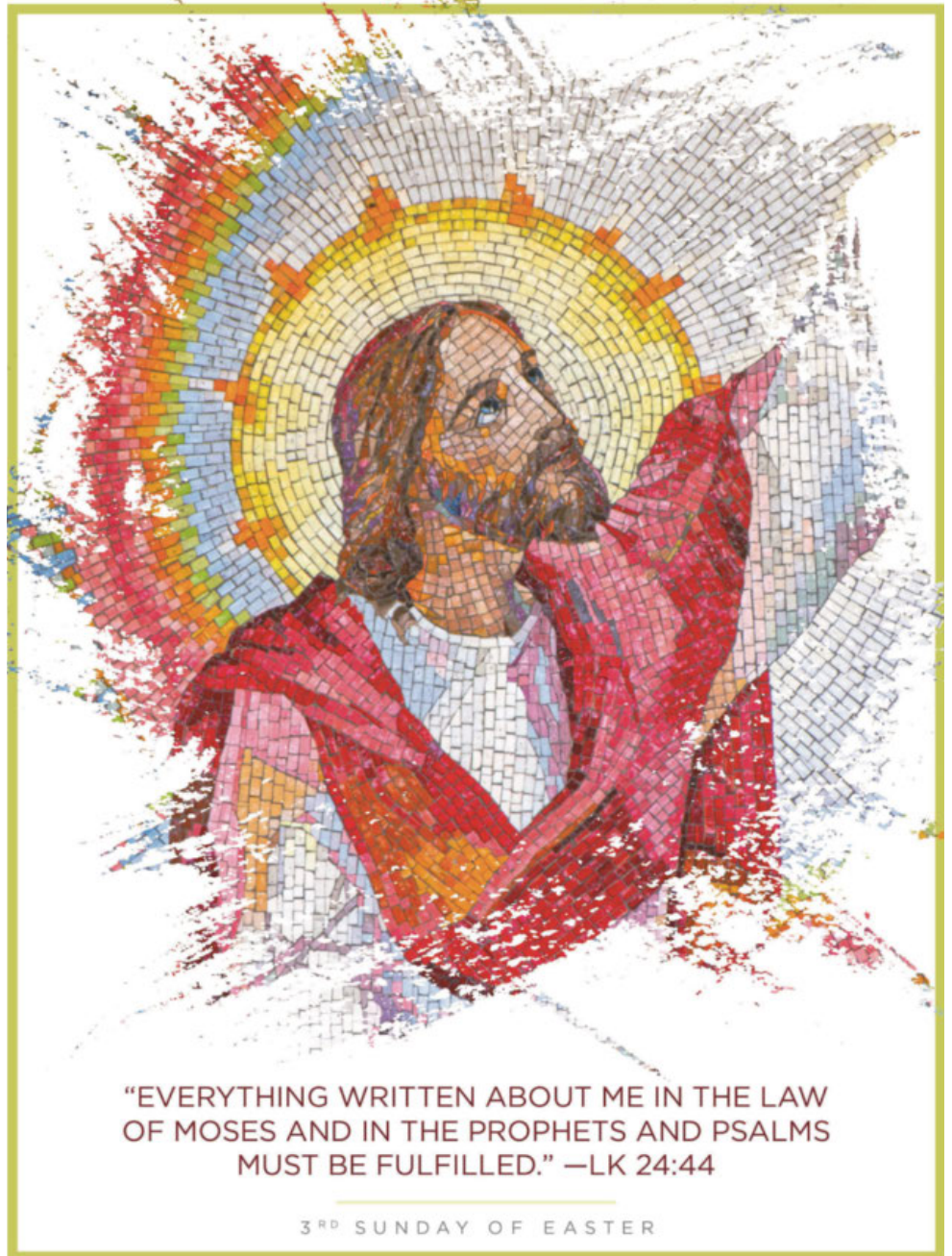

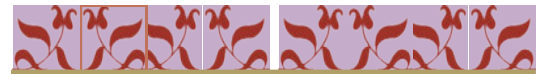

At the Easter Vigil Marc Albrecht, Colton Wells, and Karlee Paitz were received into the church through baptism, confirmation and Eucharist. Brianna Kamler, Mathew Roth, and Brady Holtmeier made a profession of faith in the Roman Catholic Church and were confirmed along with Freddy Lopez and Darrell Dunham. All of them made their first Communion. Now they have the time of Mystagogy.

From Fr. Paul Turner: Mystagogy is a period of postbaptismal catechesis. It usually coincides with the 50 days of Easter. Unbaptized adults and children of catechetical age celebrate the three sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil. That night they are baptized, receive confirmation, and share in the Eucharist for the first time. To prepare for that evening, they have spent a long time in catechetical formation, learning how to act, think, and believe as Christians do. After their baptism, in the midst of the entire community, their formation continues for a while. That period is called “mystagogy.”

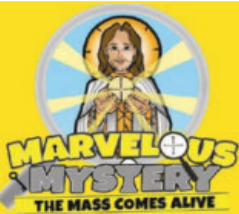
Mystagogy invites the newly baptized to participate more deeply in all the things that Christians do—meditating on the gospel, sharing in the Eucharist, and performing charity. In all this, they let the meaning of the death and resurrection of Christ take firm root in their lives. Of course, catechumens are expected to behave as Christians even before they are baptized. They should be turning away from a life of sin and turning toward Christ, establishing Him as their center. But after baptism things are different. Now they are truly one with the Christian community, even to the point of sharing in the Eucharist. With the power of the sacraments, the newly baptized are better able to live as Christians and to reflect on the gospel and its effect on their lives in a more complete way.

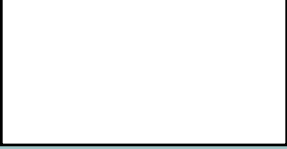
