In scripture, especially in the Gospel of John, Chapter 1, God reveals himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This mystery will take a lifetime to understand.

There is a story that St. Augustine was walking on the beach contemplating the mystery of the Trinity. He saw a boy ahead of him who had dug a hole in the sand. Again and again the boy went to the sea and brought

back water to pour into the hole. St. Augustine asked him, "What are you doing?" The boy told him, "I'm going to pour the entire ocean into this hole." St. Augustine replied, "That is impossible, the whole ocean will not fit in the hole you have made." The boy then said to him, "And you cannot fit the Trinity in your tiny little brain." The story concludes by saying that the boy vanished because St. Augustine had been talking to an angel.
