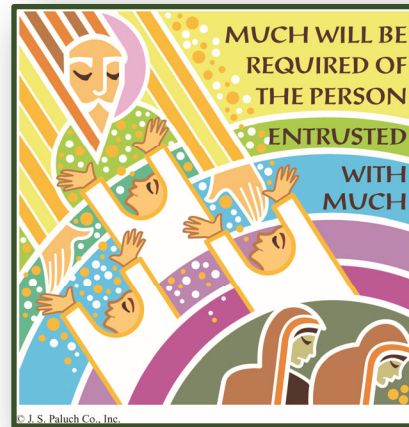

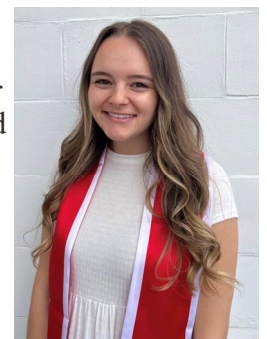

Pastor's Note: School will soon begin for many of our youth, teachers, and support staff. As a former elementary school teacher, I can share that there is a bit of sadness and joy at this time of year: the sadness of seeing summer end, but the joy and excitement of seeing the students and beginning a new year of learning.

Soon the Faith Formation classes will begin at Prince of Peace. I cannot stress enough how important it is to send your children every year to religious formation classes, from pre-school until Confirmation and beyond. Parents are the first educators in the faith.

Amy Lowe returns to start her third year as Religious Formation Coordinator for grades K-5. Parents have commented to me how they are learning with their children. Please register your child today.

The 6-11 graders will have a new youth minister and Religious Formation Coordinator, Makayla Irwin. She has been busy this summer with many of our diocesan youth camps as well as Totus Tuus. She has helped with LifeTeen and a bit with Edge. She will soon speak at all the Masses. The youth will certainly enjoy this young dynamic woman as their new youth minister.

This summer has been a time of renewal for me. The Catholic community of Kearney will have Fr. Neal Hock, pastor of the Saint Teresa of Calcutta Newman Center, Fr. Joe Hannappel pastor of St. James, and me, pastor of Prince of Peace as active duty priests. Fr. Tom Mullooney and Fr. Art Faesser are retired priests in Kearney. Kearney has been blessed to have multiple priests in both parishes in the past. We are now experiencing the clergy shortage first hand. Some pastors have three and even four parishes. Please pray for our priests and for more vocations to priesthood and religious life.

The church is depending on you now! This is the age of the laity. We are blessed with so many excellent leaders that have responded to their baptismal call to serve; some on Parish Pastoral Council, committees, boards, and through liturgical ministries at Mass. The Prince of Peace staff, many of whom are part-time, are so helpful assisting me in the church.

All of us are called to be involved some way, big or small, it all counts. We are so flexible and can work with any schedule. Won't you say, "Yes, Lord, here I am. Where do you want me to serve?" There is a special need for homebound ministry and liturgical ministers for weekend Masses.

Parish Anniversary: Our parish was dedicated August 10, 2011. Since then the landscape has become lush, the roof has been replaced, the doors stay shut, the sound system improved with audio visual capacity, and the church mortgage is now fully paid. Halleluiah! I recently discovered that every parish is to have a special mass on the anniversary of the dedication. Therefore, August 10 at 7:30 am the Mass will follow the anniversary of a parish.

We are working with the RDG architect in developing plans for the gathering area, a pre-school and repurposing the offices for more classrooms, and new offices on the upper level.
