Prince of Peace is a dynamic and vibrant parish. September 9th at 7 pm will be the first session of LifeTeen. Leeta Joslyn, the new youth minister and her team are so excited for the dynamic sessions this year. September 11th begins K-5 Faith Formation at 4 pm and 5:30 pm followed by Edge at 7 pm.

This year, we will offer LIFETEEN on Monday evenings from 7 pm to 8:30 pm. It has been our experience that Sunday has a lot of competition. Also, we have heard from families that Sunday night is family night; it is the one night they can have a meal together, play games or watch a movie, and/or finish up homework. Unless I am mistaken, most of the sports offered on Mondays are for middle school, with the exception of some JV football. I would appreciate that you give it a try! The youth are welcomed with an exciting environment with icebreakers, prayer, a teaching, small group discussion, working together to apply what is learned, a wrap up, singing and prayer. The youth and adults have so much fun they don't realize that they are learning a great deal and growing in their faith.

LIFETEEN is for the older young church. Please bring your 9th to 12th grade youth to enjoy life in a

Catholic environment. They won't regret it.






