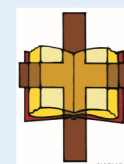
Catholic Community Food Pantry at Prince of Peace Church

In August you helped 16 families with utilities for \$1,804.06. 3 families were supported by paying \$370.00 in rent. To support learning in our area, you sent a \$250 check to United Way for the “coats for kids” program, which works with schools in our area to get the coats to where they are needed the most. Food needs continue to rise. Two pantry runs purchased \$887.94 in groceries. “Food from Farmers” program delivered food to the pantry through August. People needing funds are asked to start at the Jubilee Center. The Lord’s work continues! Thanks for being part of a great team!

September 19th is Catechetical Sunday! Prince of Peace parish has a long tradition of having an outstanding religious formation program. This weekend we recognize those who are sharing their time and talent as catechists.

Parents are the first teachers of the faith! It is said the faith is more caught than taught. What does that mean? It means that through practicing your faith, living a Christian life, attending Sunday Mass, praying in the home, before and after meals, morning and evening prayers, and occasionally making a visit to the church when the Mass is not being celebrated. From a very early age children can tell how important your faith is to you.

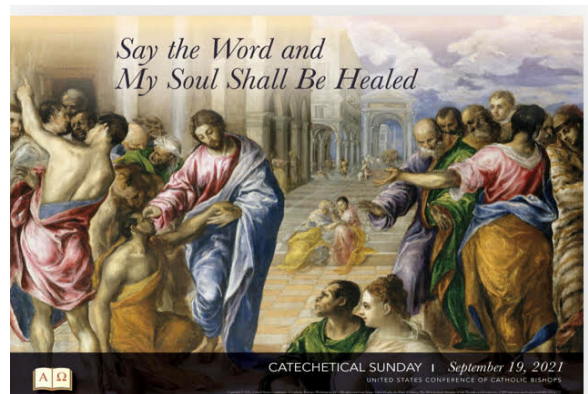
We give thanks to all of the Catechists, assistant Catechists, and helpers who will share our rich Catholic faith with our children, youth, young adults, and adults!
