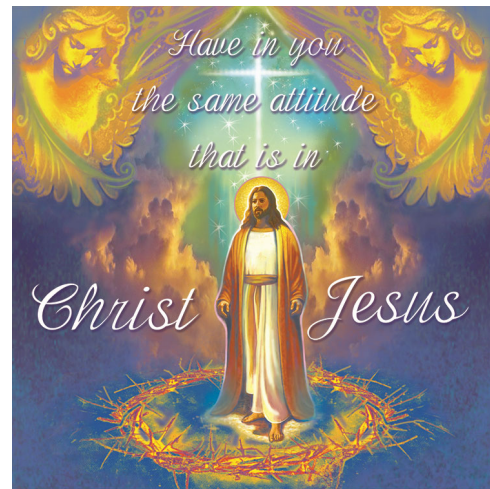

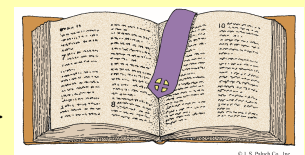

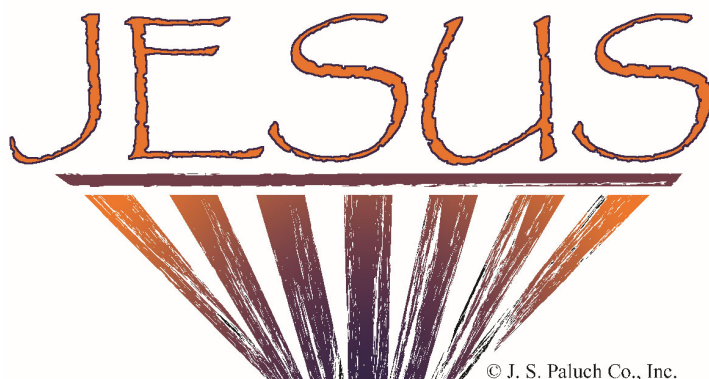

## 26th Sunday - Ordinary Time

### First Reading: Ezekiel 18:25-28

Thus says the LORD: You say, “The LORD’s way is not fair!” Hear now, house of Israel: Is it my way that is unfair, or rather, are not your ways unfair? When someone virtuous turns away from virtue to commit iniquity, and dies, it is because of the iniquity he committed that he must die. But if he turns from the wickedness he has committed, and does what is right and just, he shall preserve his life; since he has turned away from all the sins that he has committed, he shall surely live, he shall not die.

### Second Reading: Philippians 2:1-11

Brothers and sisters: If there is any encouragement in Christ, any solace in love, any participation in the Spirit, any compassion and mercy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, with the same love, united in heart, thinking one thing. Do nothing out of selfishness or out of vainglory; rather, humbly regard others as more important than yourselves, each looking out not for his own interests, but also for those of others. Have in you the same attitude that is also in Christ Jesus, Who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness; and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

### Gospel: Matthew 21:28-32

Jesus said to the chief priests and elders of the people: “What is your opinion? A man had two sons. He came to the first and said, ‘Son, go out and work in the vineyard today.’ He said in reply, ‘I will not,’ but afterwards changed his mind and went. The man came to the other son and gave the same order. He said in reply, ‘Yes, sir,’ but did not go. Which of the two did his father’s will?” They answered, “The first.” Jesus said to them, “Amen, I say to you, tax collectors and prostitutes are entering the kingdom of God before you. When John came to you in the way of righteousness, you did not believe him; but tax collectors and prostitutes did. Yet even when you saw that, you did not later change your minds and believe him.”

souls. Amen.

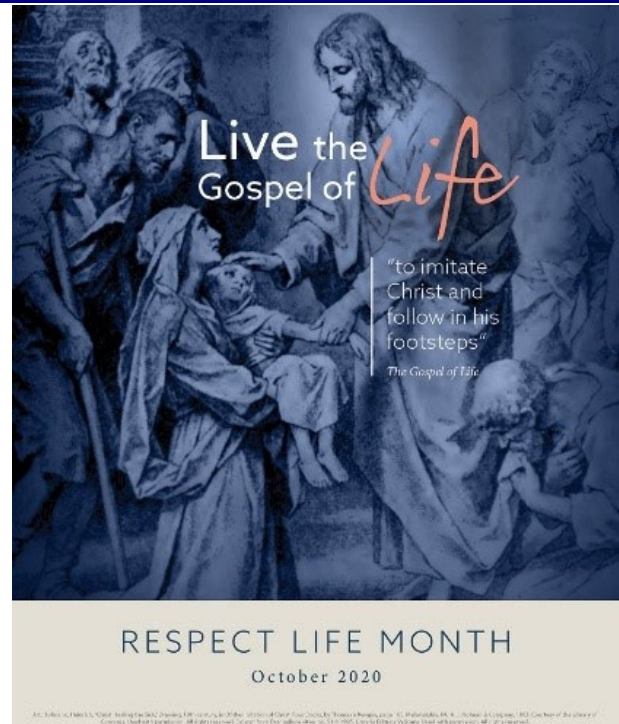
**Pastor's Note:** October is the month we highlight the Respect Life programs. This year we're also celebrating the 25th anniversary of Pope Saint John Paul II's encyclical *The Gospel of Life (Evangelium vitae)*. Our Holy Father wrote this document to reaffirm and present the Church's joyful teaching on human life within the context of modern times, and it remains relevant today. The 2020-2021 Respect Life theme is: *"Live the Gospel of Life."* It explores how Jesus, becoming human and redeeming us through his humanity, reveals the dignity of all human life. Through our baptism Jesus consecrates us and calls us his "brothers and sisters".

In the Gospel of Matthew 25:40 it says, *"Amen, I say to you whatever you did for the one of these least brothers of mine, you did it for me."* Each of us are personally entrusted with specific ways to love God and one another. Sadly, human life often faces particular threats at its beginning and end; precisely when life is in most need of protection.

If we have aging parents, do we take the time to consistently show our love through visits, phone calls and notes? If we know expectant mothers or parents with infants, do we provide support that helps them welcome their children and continues to serve their needs, even months after the baby is born?

Adoption is a choice that many parents, who are unable to conceive, hope birth parents use as an option if for whatever reason they feel that they are not the right choice for the unborn child. There are many factors that go into this decision; more than I can cover in this short note.

Every life is to be cherished from the moment of conception to natural death. The statement presented a précis of Pope St. John Paul II's evangelical charge for a renewed urgency to end the death penalty: "Through his powerful encyclical, *The Gospel of Life (Evangelium Vitae)* Pope St. John Paul has asked that governments stop using the death penalty as the ultimate penalty. The Holy Father points out instances where its application to protect society have become 'very rare, if not practically nonexistent.'" (EV n. 56). 
The Mass is still available for praying/viewing on the parish website, the YouTube parish channel, and Facebook.

**Procedures For Attending Mass**

- ◆ Everyone is strongly encouraged to wear a mask (masks are available for you at the doors if you don't have one). **When singing please wear a mask.** The restrooms are available for you at your own risk. We ask that only one person or one adult & child go at a time. Please use the restroom before you come to church.
- ◆ Use the 6-foot distancing rule; every other pew is used. The pews are marked to allow you to visualize the 6 foot sections.
- ◆ There are baskets near the doors for your offering, since we won't pass the offering basket, or you may take advantage of the on-line giving.
- ◆ If you choose to hold hands during the Our Father, you may do so only with your family.
- ◆ The sign of Peace will be done only with your family. You may give a symbol of peace or wave to those around you if you choose.
- ◆ Communion will be distributed in the hand.
