The second reading this weekend is from Philippians 4:6 and states: "Brothers and sisters:

Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God. Then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." This passage calls us to turn to God with prayer, petition, and thanksgiving. This can help deal with our anxiety and stress.

However, prayer can be difficult for people. Even the disciples asked Jesus, "Lord, teach us to pray," (Luke 11: 1) and then Jesus taught them the Lord's Prayer.

So what is prayer? Prayer is a form of communication, a way of talking to God or to the Saints. It may be formal or informal. Some examples of a formal prayer are: the Mass, the Lord's Prayer, the Hail Mary, the Glory be. The rosary is an excellent formal prayer that many people find helpful. Adoration of the Eucharist, either sitting or praying before the Tabernacle or exposition of the Eucharist, is more of a meditative method of praising and adoring Jesus.

The word pray is based on a Middle English word that means "to ask earnestly". The Latin word precari simply means to entreat or ask.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church speaks of types of prayer in paragraphs 2626 – 2643 and provides examples and pointers on how to engage in each type of prayer.

There are different types of prayer:

Blessing and Adoration: Praising God.

Contrition: Asking for God's forgiveness.


**Petition or intercession:** Asking God for a favor. **Thanksgiving:** Showing God gratitude.

It seems to me that we need to be people of prayer. I recall when I was young that we were asked to pray the rosary for the conversion of Russia....it seems we need to continue to pray for their conversion. In fact, the way things are going in the United States of America, it seems to me that we need to pray for the conversion of our country!

Let us take up the call to be a people of prayer. Let us not grow weary. Pray, pray, pray!

### Bring Awareness to Human Trafficking at Walk for Freedom Event Starts in Parking Lot D at Good Samaritan on Oct. 14

CHI Health Good Samaritan and New Life invites the community to join them on Saturday, Oct. 14 to raise awareness of human trafficking at the Walk for Freedom. The event will begin at 10 a.m. in parking lot D west of the Cancer Center on 2nd Ave. Please arrive at 9:30 a.m. Every step reduces vulnerability locally, empowering the community to identify and report trafficking suspicions. The walk is approximately 2 miles. There is no cost for the event, however participants are requested to register in advance at <a href="https://www.a21.org/register.php?">https://www.a21.org/register.php?</a> eventId=3586. All participants are encouraged to wear all black attire.

Since 2016, there have been 47 Nebraska communities with reports of human trafficking. Worldwide, millions are enslaved in this \$150 billion industry. A-21's co-founder, Christine Cain, says, "There's power in gathering together, in showing up in force, and shedding light on this injustice that is all too often hidden in plain sight."
