



The Eucharistic Prayer forms the heart of the Mass, but how well do we understand what we pray? Join us for seven weeks of contemplation on each part of the Eucharistic Prayer. These small group sessions incorporate Scripture, visual art, and music, offering integral Eucharistic formation for creating a Eucharistic culture in a parish grounded in what *The Directory for Catechesis* calls "the way of beauty."



Next weekend, after all Masses, we will host a Wall Signing!! Our precast walls are in place and now's your chance to sign your name, write a prayer or a word of blessing! Come leave your mark on our new space on October 28th/29th after Masses.

Kearney Catholic High School excited about activities complex project and invites your participation

After more than 50 years of limited outdoor facilities at Kearney Catholic High School, funds are being raised for major improvements to the space surrounding Miles Field. The facility will include a turf field, which maximizes practice space on the landlocked site, an eight-lane track, ADA-compliant bleachers, a building for storage designed to double as a training room, and meeting rooms for teams, and – what excites people the most – modern restrooms.

The turf field will provide improved practice space for the Star's Marching Band, which, under the direction of Lindsay Lund, has received Superior ratings at the NSBA State Marching Competition for the last two years, as well as numerous parade and field show accolades. Additionally, the Kearney Catholic Soccer Programs will be able to practice and host home games on-site.

In 2019 and 2020, the school had site plans prepared to begin work on the project, but the COVID pandemic occurred precisely when the school anticipated the final green light to move forward. Understandably, time, energy, and financial resources were redirected towards COVID response, causing a pause in the project.

During 2022, The Kearney Catholic School Board, along with the Foundation Board, invested time and resources in a strategic planning process that engaged both the school community and the greater Kearney community to establish a 5-year vision for growth in eight domains. Although significant improvements have been made to the school in the last two decades, including a new foyer, chapel, renovated office space, additional classrooms, and science labs, renovating the outdoor space was a priority raised throughout the strategic planning process.

The completed field will be open for community use when not being used for school activities, including use by other area schools, nonprofits, and events. Completing this project is a win for the school and the community. While generous donors have pledged half of the funds needed for the projected \$6.5 million project and we await word on submitted grant applications, we invite you to participate as well. Kearney Catholic hopes for the project to begin as soon as funding can be secured.

Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit




will be at Prince of Peace Friday, October 27th— November 1st, 2023
