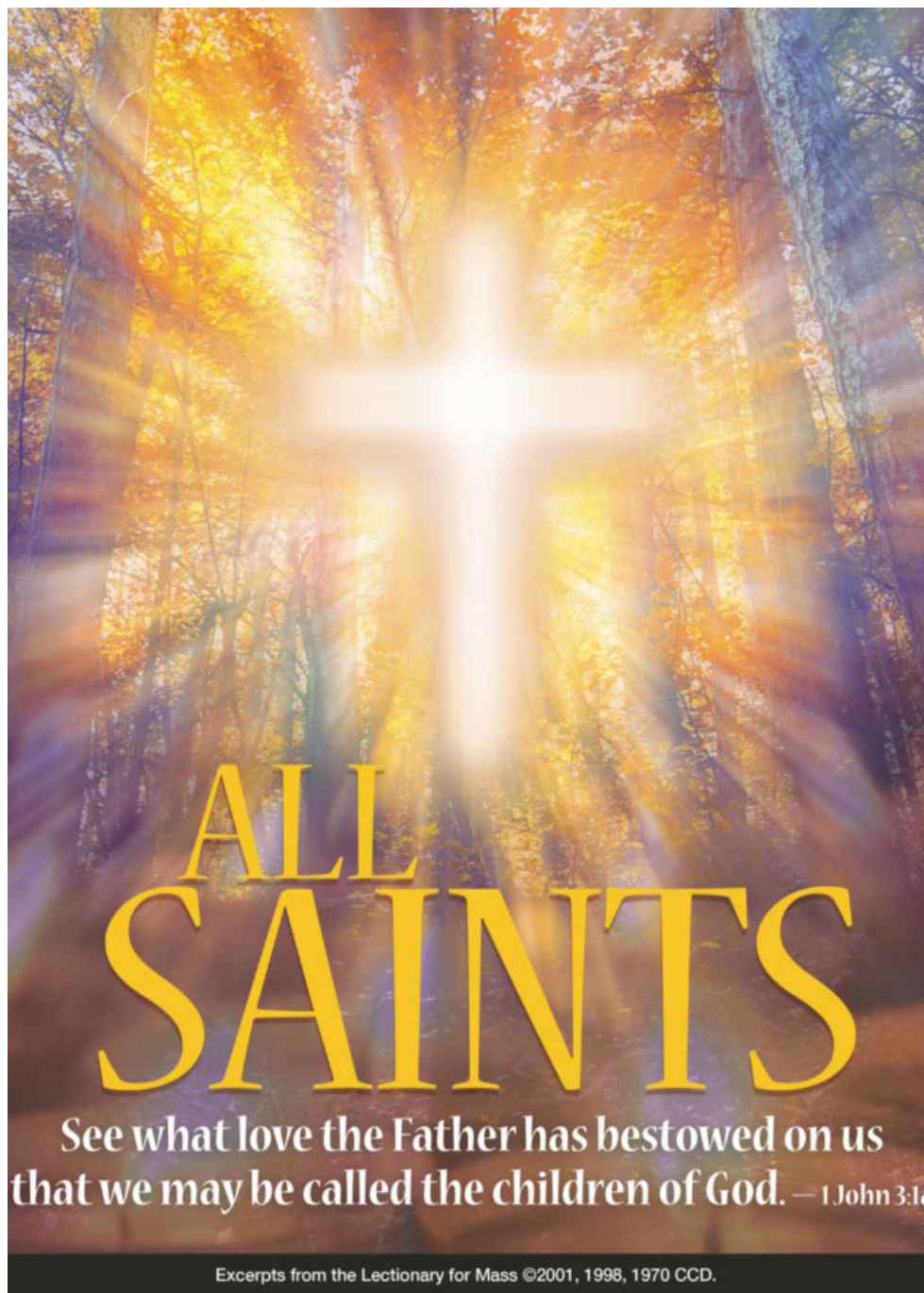

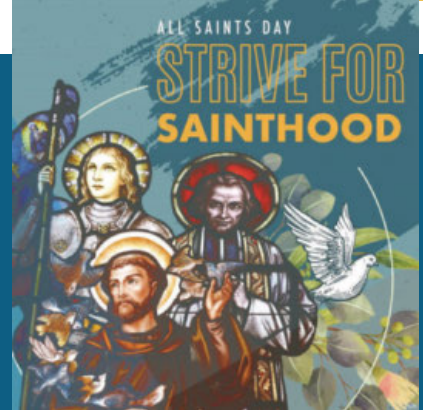

STEWARDSHIP

Last Sunday we began Stewardship renewal, or our re-commitment to discipleship. As Jesus Called the Disciples to follow him, so he calls us. We have heard his call. It seems to me that if you are reading this column you have responded to this call.

Stewardship is best understood by what the USCCB defines as a way of life, following the four pillars of stewardship: hospitality, prayer, formation, and service.

As a church, we are called to be the face of Christ for one another. We can do this by practicing the spirit of hospitality; a warm smile can make anyone feel welcomed.

The first Pillar of Stewardship is hospitality. Part of hospitality is not only visiting the people we know, but risking getting to know others that we might only see in church. Being a church that demonstrates hospitality is sharing with each other our joys and our sorrows, our failures and our successes. It is being a family. Jesus was hospitable.

The second pillar of stewardship is prayer. Prayer is talking to God. If we feel loved by God, it is logical that we want to pray to God. We have wonderful Masses every weekend, and weekday Masses. Many people love to spend time adoring the Lord in Eucharistic adoration. Won't you make a commitment to pray daily? Jesus was a man of prayer.

The third pillar of Stewardship is formation. This challenges us to not stop our faith formation as many do with Confirmation, but continue satisfying our hungry heart by allowing the Lord to form us, mold us, and use us as He wills. Won't you commit to allowing

God to form you through taking advantage of the many offerings of study groups, workshops, retreats, and much more that Prince of Peace offers? Jesus formed his disciples by word and example.

The fourth pillar of Stewardship is Service. When many of us think of stewardship we often think of service. Indeed this is an important part of stewardship. Hopefully you are able to understand that each pillar builds on the previous. When we feel loved by God, we desire to pray. When we pray, we are given the desire to learn more about our God. When we learn more about our God, we have the passion to serve our God. We are in great need for more volunteers to serve in all areas at Mass.

Through the four pillars of stewardship, we understand that being a good steward is a grateful response to God's Love. Everything we have is a gift. When we return to the Lord a portion of what God has given us, we are blessed 100 times over. Jesus gave his life to service of God and us!

Next weekend you will be asked recommit to being a good steward through filling

out the commitment form. I ask that all of us fill out the front page that asks for name, address etc., so we will be able keep our parish registry up to date. Please fill out where you might want to return to the Lord through prayer and service. I also invite you to take a leap of faith and make a commitment to make a tithe to the Lord. No amount is too small. We cannot outdo God in generosity. This will help us with our budgeting and it will help all of us to make a sacrificial gift to the Lord through tithing.

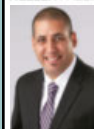

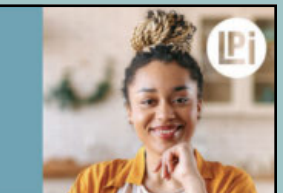
