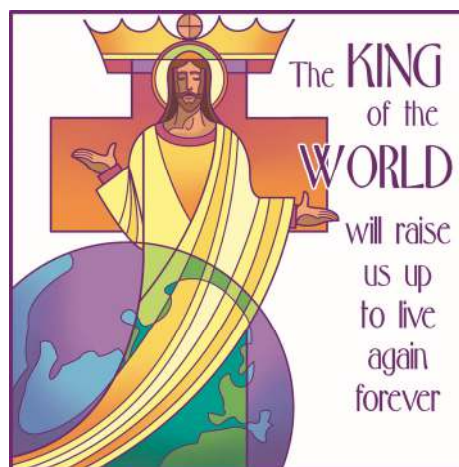

Pastor's note: November 17th at the 10:30 am Mass, 35 total youth will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Some are from St. James as our class time was more convenient for them. Each of them had to write a paper about the Saint they chose and why they chose him or her. They also had to write a letter to Bishop Hanefeldt answering questions he requested. He read them all and was impressed with their enthusiasm for the faith and the love of our church community.

The last two weekends we have been talking about the Annual Diocesan Appeal. Our Bishop sent you a letter, a pamphlet, and a giving card. Please make the checks payable to the Grand Island Diocese. The Gospel this weekend speaks of the Widow who gave from her want. Jesus commented saying, *"Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood."*

Being good Stewards does not require a lot of us; only a percentage of all that God has given to us. Please return to the Lord a percentage of your treasure. 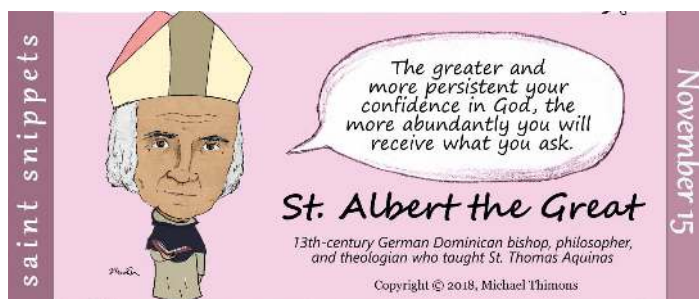
