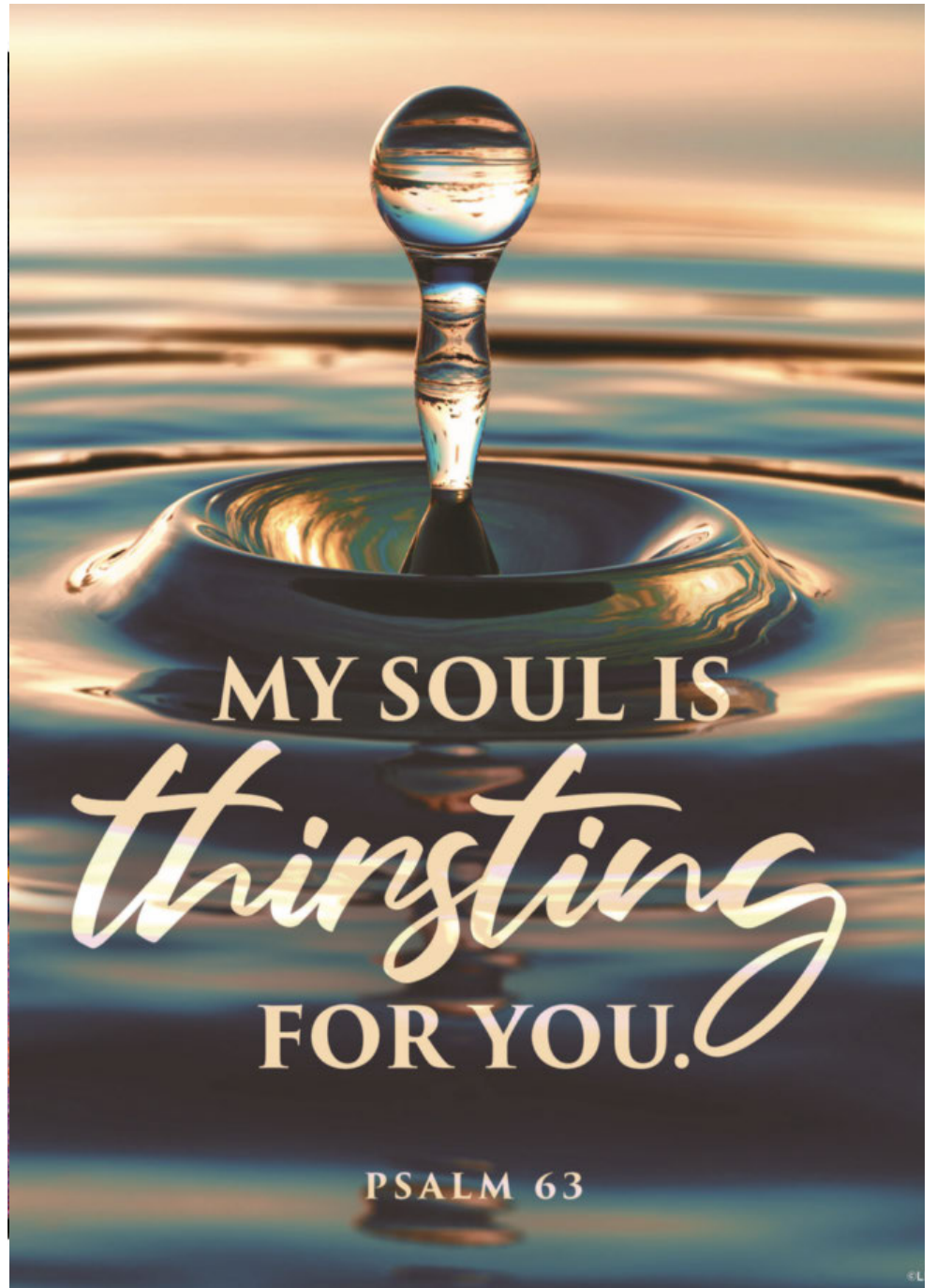

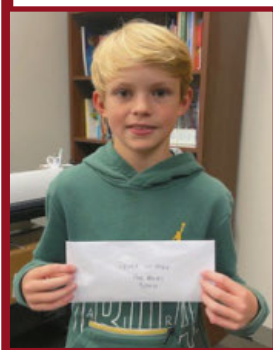

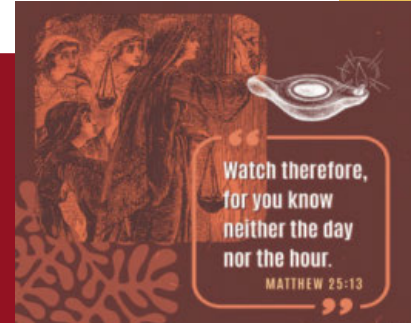

Worship of the Eucharist Outside of Mass

As Dean of the Kearney Deanery, I am to represent the priests and the people of this deanery on the Bishops Presbyterial Council. We meet six times each year and discuss the affairs of the church in the Diocese of Grand Island. We met last Thursday, November 2. During this meeting, Bishop Hanefeldt impressed upon us that terminology matters.

Recently, Fr. Sagar and I attended the FDLC (Federation of Diocesan Liturgical Commissions). Usually, they have vendors who sponsor meals or breaks etc. in order to have the privilege of displaying their products. Since we are still in the Eucharistic Revival, there were many books, some rituals, etc. on the Eucharist.

One that caught my eye was "Guide for celebrating Worship of the Eucharist Outside of Mass," by Fr. John Thomas Lane with the *Nihil Obstat* being the Very Reverend Daniel A. Smilanic, JCD and the *Imprimatur*, the Very Reverend Ronald A. Hicks, both of the Archdiocese of Chicago.

He begins with a chapter called, "The Theology and History of the Eucharistic Worship Outside of Mass". As stated, terminology is important. Fr. Lane is frequently providing definition for words that Catholic use. He does this so that we may have a common understanding of the terms. For example, The Eucharist is our most important Catholic liturgy, the Mass. The word **Eucharist** comes from the Greek word *eucharistein*, which means "thanksgiving" or "to give thanks". From the *Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (CSL)*, 7, he reminds us that, "When we come together to celebrate the Mass, Christ is present in many ways: the assembly, the proclamation of the Word, in the presider, and most especially in the Eucharist." From *Lumen gentium (LG)*, 11, comes the phrase that the **Mass** is the primary worship for Catholics: it is the "source and summit" of Christian life." We are called to become what we consume, Christ, for one another. For this reason, the Mass ends with a mission: "Go and proclaim the Gospel." We are to be Christ hands, feet, and eyes, to practice the corporal works of mercy: feed the hunger, visit the sick and the imprisoned, clothe the naked, and bury the dead.

As I wrote in an earlier bulletin, "Furthermore, the sacred species are reserved after Mass principally so that the faithful who cannot be present at Mass, above all the sick and those advanced in age, may be united by sacramental Communion to Christ and his Sacrifice which is offered in the Mass. Thus, all our devotions, including hours of adoration in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, need to flow from the Mass, and

not vice versa. This reservation of the Eucharist also permits the practice of adoring this great Sacrament and offering it the worship due to God. Accordingly, these forms of adoration are not only private but also public and communitarian in nature, as established or approved by the Church herself." S. Congregation for Divine Worship, Decree, *Eucharistiae sacramentum*, 21 June 1973: AAS 65 (1973) 610. T

From the ritual book *Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist Outside of Mass (HCW)*, 82 "In addition to the celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic devotions are important for the life of the parish for they [invite] us to the spiritual union with him that culminates in the sacramental communion."

Next week I will share Fr. Lane's definitions of terms associated with prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. -Fr. Paul Colling


