

The third Sunday of Advent is called Rejoice Sunday or Gaudete. In Latin the full phrase is Gaudete in Domino simper or Rejoice Mass on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day. in the Lord always. The liturgical color for the

day is rose to signify joy and hope. The time of waiting is almost over and Christmas will soon be here.

This year the fourth Sunday of Advent falls on December 24<sup>th</sup>. As we know one of the precepts of the Church is: You shall attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor. We must, "sanctify the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord," (Sunday), as well as the principal feast days, known

as Catholic holy days of obligation. This requires attending Mass. December 23<sup>rd</sup> will be the Mass of anticipation at 5 pm and Sunday, December 24<sup>th</sup>, there will only be a 10:30 am Mass.

December 25<sup>th</sup>, Christmas is also a holy day of obligation but most people desire to attend

The Christmas Eve schedule; 4 pm;

6:30 pm and 9 pm; Christmas day at 9 am. Our hope is that everyone who wants to attend Christmas Eve can do so comfortably. This won't work if everyone decides to attend the 4 pm Christmas Eve Mass. I make a plea to all of you to consider 6:30 pm Mass or 9 pm Mass on Christmas Eve. Each Mass will have special music that will enrich our worship. Christmas Day at 9 am is a wonderful Mass to attend.
