




First Communion is on May 4th at 2:00 PM.

No bikes, scooters, etc. Only strollers or wheelchairs


No gum or sunflower seeds No tobacco

Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!

Anyone who participated in the Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil surely must have been spiritually moved!

Divine Mercy Sunday: The second Sunday of Easter is also Divine Mercy Sunday. The devotion was actively promoted by Pope John

Paul II. On April 30, 2000, the Canonization of Faustina Kowalska took place and the Sunday after Easter was officially designated as the Sunday of the Divine Mercy in the General Roman Calendar.

On April 22, 2001, which was one year after establishing Divine Mercy Sunday, Pope John Paul II re-emphasized its message in the resurrection context of Easter: Jesus said to St. Faustina one day: "Humanity will never find

peace until it turns with trust to *Divine Mercy.*" Divine Mercy! This is the Easter gift that the Church receives from the risen Christ and offers to humanity.

The devotion to Divine Mercy Sunday grew rapidly after its designation by Pope John Paul II and is now widely celebrated by Catholics.


Transitions: For those who attended Palm Sunday, you
