

## Supporting Catholic Education at Kearney Catholic

Kearney Catholic High School is sustained through a partnership of families, parishes, and the broader community. Teacher salaries and insurance account for 68% of the operating budget. Since establishing the Annual Star Fund in 2022, teacher base salary has increased from 83.4% to 88.5% of Kearney Public Schools' base salary, helping strengthen stability in the classroom. This March, through Match Madness, a generous donor will match gifts dollar-for-dollar up to \$50,000 in support of teacher salaries. ## THE CATHOLIC MOVEMENTS OR DEVOTIONS? What Next After Confirmation or O.C.I.A?

**Have you ever asked yourself, after faith formation, or OCIA, or Confirmation what's next? Or wondered how you can help your child to remain in or construct his/her faith? Would you like to improve your spirituality and more knowledge about Christ? How can I build my faith?** Through the inspiration of the holy spirit there are many church movements and devotions, approved by the church to help a Christian to remain active in his or her spiritual life and growth.

**What is a devotion?** They are popular prayers, rituals and pious practices used by individuals or groups to worship God or venerate Mary and the saints. They express a particular conviction about the object of the devotion: They create the ability of time and space, nature, human relationships and human activity to mediate the presence, love and, grace of an Incarnate God. **Some of them are as below:**

### THE LEGION OF MARY: A NEW CATHOLIC MOVEMENT YOU WOULD NOT WANT TO MISS IN KEARNEY

The Legion of Mary is the largest international apostolic lay association in the Catholic Church, with over 10 million active and auxiliary members dedicated to evangelization and personal sanctification. Founded in Dublin in 1921, members perform voluntary service such as **visiting the sick, prison ministry, and door-to-door evangelization** in pairs.

It involves praying the Holy Rosary and offering our commitment to our lady Maria every week. The Rosary prayed is like a flower to save souls. All the Rosaries prayed help Mother Mary bring more souls to her son. The **legionaries are soldiers of Mary**, helpers of Mother Mary. Soldiers who use the Rosary as a tool to win souls and as a shield to protect themselves against the evil Satan.

#### KEY ASPECTS OF THE LEGION OF MARY:

**Structure:** The basic unit is the praesidium, which meets weekly for prayer, reporting, and assignment of tasks. It is one of the movements which is internationally organized and united. (In Kearney we shall be meeting once every week after Easter, at Prince of Peace Catholic Church.

**Mission:** The primary goal is the, "glory of God through the holiness of its members," developed by prayer and active apostolic work.

**Spirituality:** The organization is deeply Marian, following a path based on St. Louis Marie de Montfort's, "True Devotion to Mary." A legionary commits him/herself to a daily recitation of the Rosary.

**Membership:** The legionary has two types of membership. 1) **Active members**, and 2) **Auxiliary Members**. Active members perform at least two hours of weekly work which may include (visiting the sick, the old, prisoners, hospital patients, charity, etc but offering that work as a prayer); while auxiliary members support the mission through prayer. Legionaries meet once a week.



#### KEY BENEFITS OF JOINING THE LEGION OF MARY:

**Spiritual Growth & Formation:** Weekly meetings include the Rosary, prayers, and spiritual readings, helping members grow in faith and virtue. **It is a personal invitation of our Lady to you.** Mother Mary is whispering to you, and she invites you to listen to it. It is a personal encounter with God through Mary. **Active Evangelization:** Members participate in practical, hands-on ministry such as visiting the sick, nursing homes, or door to door evangelization to bring others closer to Christ. **Deepened Marian Devotion:** The organization is based on the spiritual teachings of St. Louis Marie de Montfort, fostering a close, loving relationship with the Blessed Mother. **Community and Support:** Provides fellowship with other Catholic adults, fostering friendships in a supportive, prayerful environment. **Structured Service (Tithing of Time):** Members commit to about two hours of weekly, in-person apostolic work, which acts as a "tithing" of time and effort to God. **Increased Confidence in Faith:** The Legion trains members to defend and explain Church doctrines in a modern world. **Spiritual Benefits:** Members are supported by the prayers of the entire organization, with Masses offered for them

**Other church devotions and movements include;** Devotion to the Sacred Heart, Divine Mercy the **Xaverian Movement, St Jude Movement, St Joseph's Movement, The Catholic Charismatic Renewal, Apostleship of Prayer, Devotion to the Precious Blood, Eucharistic Adoration, Way of the Cross.** etc,


