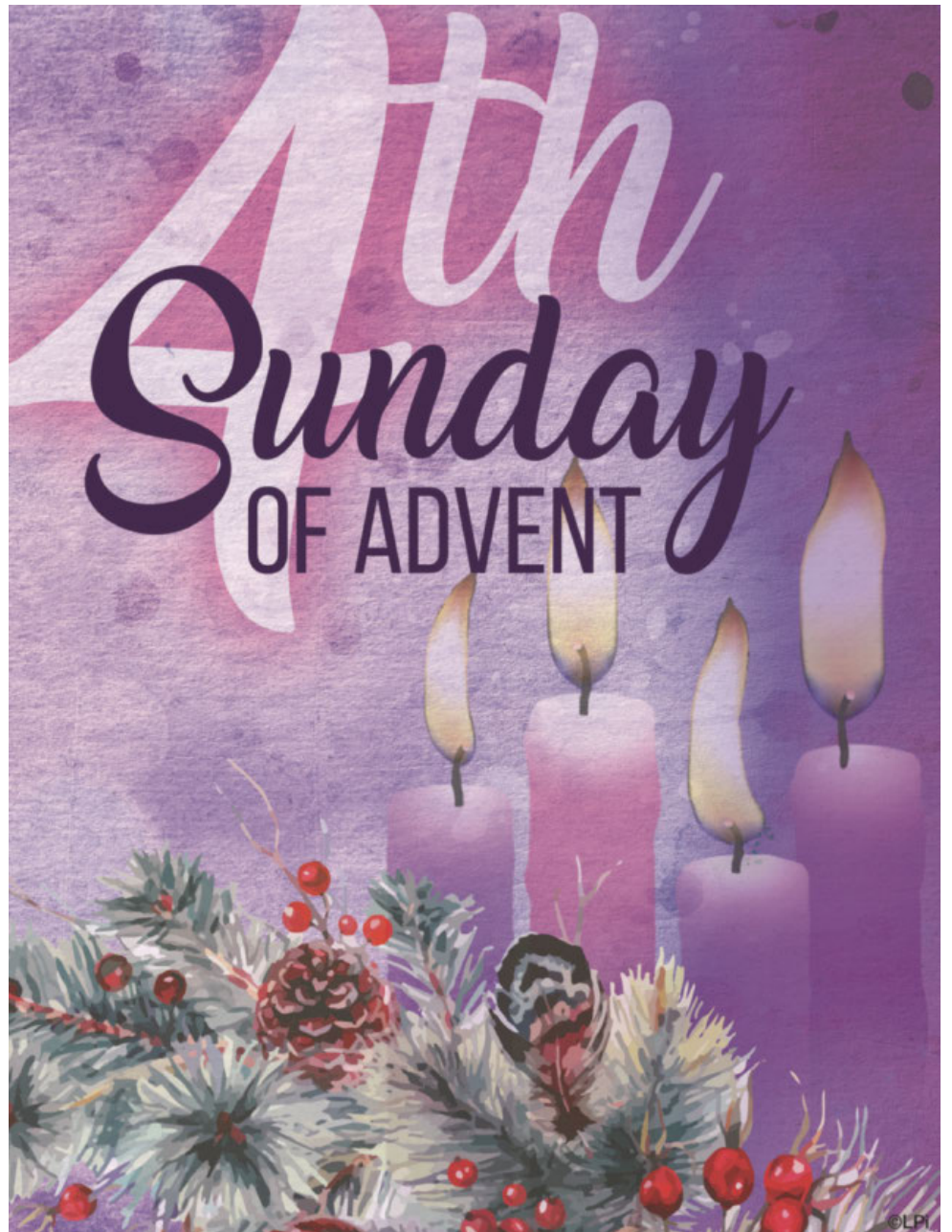



Holy Innocents Mass of Healing on Friday, December 27 5:15 PM at St. Mary's Cathedral in Grand Island

On December 28, Catholics celebrate the Feast of the Holy Innocents, Martyrs, in remembrance of the children slaughtered by King Herod in his quest to kill the newborn Jesus. Many families struggle with miscarriage, still birth, infant death or even abortion. This Mass of healing and hope is to pray with families to celebrate the brief lives of these children, and to seek God's mercy and hope in our suffering. 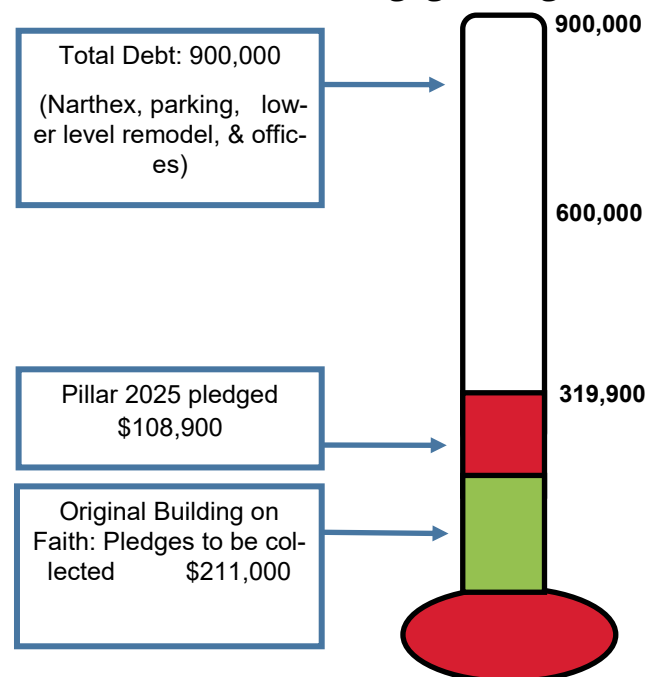
It is exciting to tell you that we had \$108,900 in new pledges or one-time gifts before commitment Sunday, December 15th. This will really help us take down the debt.
