To What Extent Can A Priest Refuse To Bury Your Loved One?

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When one loses a loved one, he or she expects consolation from those they know. The church at this time exercises its closeness to the grieving family and it is always positive towards the grieving family.

In the Catholic Church, a priest cannot legally refuse to bury a Catholic loved one if the family or the deceased themselves request it, provided the burial is in accordance with Church law. Canon law (Can. 1176) states that, “deceased members of the Christian faithful must be given ecclesiastical funerals according to the norm of law.” This means the Church is obliged to provide a funeral rite, which includes burial, unless there are specific exceptions.

This generally holds true even if, at the time of death, the deceased person wasn’t a regularly practicing Catholic. Elderly persons and other shut-ins, for example, who would perhaps be attending Mass regularly if they were physically able to get there, can be buried with Catholic funeral rites from the local Catholic parish. This holds true even if the pastor there had never before been made aware of the shut-in’s presence within the boundaries of his parish! The deceased needn’t have been a registered or contributing member of a parish to be entitled to a Catholic funeral.

Can a priest therefor refuse to celebrate funeral Mass for the dead?

The answer is yes but only in very limited circumstances provided by the Church's law. The Church may, and occasionally does, refuse Catholic funeral rites to Catholics in certain specific situations.

Canon 1184 states that ecclesiastical funerals are to be denied only to those who, before death:

- notoriously rejected the Catholic faith through apostasy, heresy, or schism.
- chose cremation for reasons contrary to the Christian faith.
- whose funeral would cause public scandal, unless they gave some sign of repentance before death.

What about non-Catholics?

When a non-Catholic dies, especially where the surviving family is Catholic, a priest exercises pastoral charity. A baptized person from a non-Catholic church may be permitted to have Catholic funeral rites, if (a) a minister from his own church is unavailable; (b) the diocesan bishop does not disapprove; and (c) the deceased person did not give any indication during life that he did not want such a funeral. Your friend or partner may be a non-Catholic, but evidently, he or she is not violently opposed to the Catholic faith, since he agreed to marry you in a Catholic church and did not prevent your children from being raised as Catholics. Unless he or she has specifically stated that he does not want to be buried with Catholic funeral rites, it seems reasonable to conclude that he or she would not be against it. And if there is no church of his denomination in the region where you live, then obviously no minister of his or her church is available to conduct his funeral.

So should you find yourself obliged to make funeral arrangements for someone in the future, approach your pastor and tell him the situation. Unless your bishop has a reason for preventing it, your spouse or relative should be able to have Catholic funeral rites, including a Mass, ordinarily reserved for Catholics according to the Church's law

Mary's Pregnancy in weeks 25-27.



Baby may grow to about 15½ inches and weigh around three pounds. He will open his eyes and practice breathing and swallowing more. He may experience hiccups as his lungs continue to develop.



Baby's startle reflexes and muscle tone are developing. You may be able to hear His heartbeat by pressing your ear to Mary's stomach at 27 weeks.

Mary's hair may seem thick and lustrous because normal hair loss is suppressed by pregnancy hormones. She may also experience mild swelling in extremities and should avoid sitting or standing for long periods of time and should stay hydrated.
