"Amen, amen, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit" John 12: 24

This passage is taken from the Gospel of the Fifth Sunday of Lent. Out of great love, Jesus died on the cross for us. His death and resurrection produced much fruit; the forgiveness of our sins, eternal life, and a believing Christian community. Jesus' death on the cross is often referred to as sacrificial love. During Lent, we are invited to love as Jesus loves us. Since we are mere mortals, we cannot love as Jesus loves us: unconditionally. However, we can practice in sacrificial love.

So what is sacrificial love? According to Bing, "Sacrificial love is selfsacrifice, with pure motivation to alleviate the suffering of others." Those who enter into the sacrament of marriage are to sacrifice for one another out of love; that is to suffer for the good or the sake of their spouse or child. It is a love that is committed to helping others regardless of the cost. It is bearing with the failings and weaknesses of others. It is not easy. Without divine assistance, we cannot even begin to love as Jesus loved. Our efforts will be in vain. But with God's grace and our committed effort, we can live a life of love, and at times, sacrificial love.

Doing this of our own free will is an example of sacrificial love. If we do it because "we have too" then it is not. If the action is not done freely; if it is a duty or a demand, then it is an action that is not a gift of love. If we choose to give something up or perform an action for the good, or for the sake, of another, then this is an example of sacrificial love.

This gospel passage calls us to examine our motivation and perceptions. It challenges to consider why we do what we do? None of us can totally love like Jesus loved, but we can make attempts. The future will inevitably give us many opportunities to love our sisters and brothers by giving up some of our wants, desires and dreams.

When you come to church, I invite you to look at the cross. Jesus death on the cross is a perfect example of sacrificial love...a love worth striving for.






Welcome packets for new parishioners available at each church entrance.
