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**46<sup>th</sup> Annual Woman's Club of Chevy Chase  
Community Art Show and Sale**  
April 1 – 3, 2022

After hosting an online art show in 2021, the Woman's Club of Chevy Chase (WCCC) is returning to an **in-person** art show and sale, to be held Friday, April 1 through Sunday, April 3. The show remains largely the same, with some changes necessitated by the pandemic. In addition, this year we are able to offer electronic registration and payment. Here in brief are the changes we've made:

- 1. Submitting your Call for Entries registration form:** About February 1, the Call for Entries form will be sent via email to artists who have been in our shows over the previous three years or who have indicated an interest in participating. It will also be available on the WCCC website. This show is not juried and all entries that conform to the entry conditions will be accepted until our maximum capacity is reached.
- 2. An added category and a renamed category:** We have added a tenth category, "Other Media." Artists can enter 2-D works in media such as glass, wood, fiber, and metal. Pieces must be work that can be hung. We have also renamed the "Mini" category; it is now called "Smalls."
- 3. Reduced show size; reduced "Smalls" category:** Pandemic-related changes have caused us to reduce the show size to 375 works of art, down from 450. The "Smalls" maximum has been reduced to 4 (down from 6).
- 4. Electronic submission and payment:** You will be able to submit your Call for Entries form via US mail or electronically on the WCCC website; details will be in the Call for Entries form. If you mail your form, you will include a check; if you submit it electronically you will pay online by credit card at the time of submission.
- 5. Notification of artists:** We will email or text each artist within ten days of receipt of their form to confirm that we received their submission. If you do not receive confirmation after ten days, please contact us via the art show email: [wcccartshow@gmail.com](mailto:wcccartshow@gmail.com).

**ACCOMMODATIONS AND CHANGES RELATED TO COVID:**

- 1. Masks:** All visitors to the building must wear masks that cover their nose and mouth.
- 2. Social distancing:** The drop-off and pick-up hours will be expanded so that fewer artists are present at any given time. In addition, the show layout will be changed so that we can accept artwork at the patio doors, eliminating the need for artists and volunteers to congregate in the building. We will follow the Montgomery County guidelines regarding the cap on the number of people in the building at any one time.
- 3. Judge's commentary and opening night reception:** It is unlikely because of the pandemic that we will be able to hold an in-person opening night reception; we will make that decision closer to the show date. If we don't feel we can offer a live event, the judge's commentary will be offered as a virtual event, as it was for last year's online show.
- 4. Show cancellation:** We will hold an in-person show, if permitted by pandemic conditions as the show date approaches. The decision to cancel will be made no later than Friday, March 25. If we cancel the show, we will return all entry fees, deducting a small fee to cover administrative costs. Note that there are no plans to switch to a virtual show; doing so requires resources that are not available to us this year.
