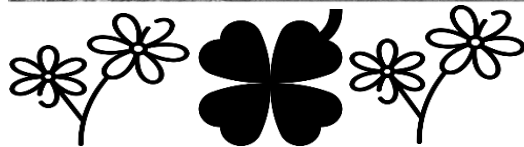

Dear WCCC members,

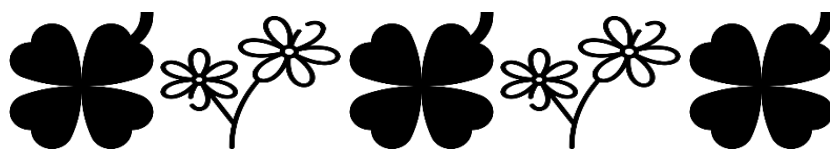
Happy spring! Our usual educational and philanthropic activities continue in March, and we welcome the return of Threads and preparations for another exciting Art Show. We also have good news to share:
