**RESOLUTION 2018 - 29**

**RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS  
OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION**

The Board of Trustees, German Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, met in a SPECIAL SESSION open to the public on July 30, 2018 at the German Township Hall, located at 12102 St. Rt. 725 West, Germantown, Ohio 45327. The following members were present:

Jacob Stubbs -	Yes

Abra Reed moved the adoption of the following RESOLUTION:

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of German Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, have determined that it is necessary to levy a tax outside of the ten mill limitation for German Township, Montgomery County. And;

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of German Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, proposes that said tax be an additional levy for the German Township Road District operation expenses as specified in Section 5705.19 (G) of the Ohio Revised Code. And;

WHEREAS, the levy shall be at a rate two (2.0) mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to 20 cents (\$.20) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years commencing in Tax Year 2018, first due in calendar year 2019

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Auditor has certified the total current tax valuation of the UNINCORPORATED area of German Township and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy annually,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of German Township, Montgomery County, two-thirds of all the members elected there to concurring:

Section 1: that the Board of Trustees of German Township, Montgomery County, hereby determines to proceed with the additional levy and the question of said tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the UNINCORPORATED portions of German Township, Montgomery County, at the General Election to be held on November 6, 2018. If said tax is

approved by a majority of said electors, such tax levy shall first be placed upon the 2018 tax list and duplicate, for first collection in calendar year 2019.

Section 2: That the Fiscal Officer of the Board of Trustees of German Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of the Elections, Montgomery County, Ohio, not less than ninety (90) days before the date of said election upon which it will be voted and to notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

Jacob Stubbs seconded the motion and the roll call being called upon its adoption, the vote resulted as follows:

## Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue For German Township

(Use this form when a taxing authority certifies a millage rate  
and requests the revenue produced by that rate.)

The County Auditor of Montgomery County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:

1. On July 24, 2018, the taxing authority of German Township certified a copy of its resolution ordinance adopted July 9, 2018, requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the unincorporated township and the amount of revenue that would be produced by two (2.00) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to twenty cents (\$0.20) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation for the general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges, in municipal corporations, counties, or townships pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §5705.19 (G), to be placed on the ballot at the November 6, 2018 general election. The levy type is a 2.00 Mill Additional Levy for a five (5) year period of time.
2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the taxing authority district remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$172,113.
3. The total tax valuation of the taxing authority district used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$90,585,690.
